


SHARED ACCOUNTABILITY

- Chancellor Patty Charlton is working closely with Superintendent Jhone Ebert in support of Nevada's Acing Accountability framework established in response to SB 98 and other bills from 2023 Legislative Session, including:
 - Mastery of Literacy (K-3)
 - Proficiency in Mathematics (4-8)
 - College and Career Readiness (Concurrent and Dual Enrollment).
- NSHE Office of Institutional Research is working on refinement of data collection to identify and report on credentials earned by NSHE students that lead to initial teacher licensure in Nevada.
- NSHE and its institutions are collaborating with NDE, CCSD and GOWINN to implement AB 428.
- Superintendent Ebert is participating with NSHE on a task force to refine Nevada's higher education math pathways, and ultimately, work on alignment with K-12 math.
