SUBJECT: The Nevada Department of Education (NDE) Consolidated Federal

(Title I- A, Title I-C, Title I-D subparts 1 &2, Title II-A, Title III-A,

Title III- Immigrant) and State Grant Timelines Clarification¹

The Nevada Department of Education Grants, Fiscal, and Program Offices must ensure that Federal grant funds are administered in accordance to applicable Federal and State laws and regulations.

Goal 6 of the Nevada State Board of Education is, "Efficient and effective use of public funds to achieve the highest return on educational investment." To help meet this goal, NDE is focusing on establishing an improved reconciliation process and establish a goal of zero reversion of state and federal funding.

A part of this process is to set clear timelines for LEA's and SEA to adhere by in order to tighten fiscal process both at the state and local level. The reconciliation process serves as a control to ensure the appropriateness, accuracy, and auditability of all approved transactions allowed by the terms of the initial grant award. Due dates and deadlines are set by the USDE and the NDE to support LEAs in maintaining fiscal control and fund accounting procedures that insure proper disbursement of and accounting for Federal funds.¹

This guidance memo supersedes any previous NDE guidance on this topic and will be remain in effect until December 31, 2019 or until further notice from NDE

Both state and federal assurances currently include the same reconciliation frequencies: "Monthly requests for reimbursements are due to the NDE by the 15th of the month for the previous month of services."

To comply with the assurances, NDE will establish and enforce timelines to adhere to the monthly requests beginning in FY 20. In the interim, the NDE has determined FY 18 and 19 due dates with the flexibility of quarterly due dates.
