

Nevada's 2018 Rising Stars Schools

Overview

Rising Stars Schools meet the designation criteria for Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) under Nevada's federally approved Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Plan. The Rising Stars Schools list identifies schools eligible for supports and interventions. Rising Stars Schools also qualify for additional funding support through state and federal programs.

Eligibility Categories

Rising Stars Schools (also known as CSI schools) meet at least one of the following criteria

- Are in the lowest 5% of schools based on their Index Score on the Nevada School Performance Framework¹ (NSPF)
- Received a 1-Star rating on the Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF)
- Are high schools with a graduation rate below 67%

Rising Stars School Cohorts

Once a school is identified as a Rising Stars School, it will remain a part of that cohort for three years, with the goal of achieving at least a 3-Star rating by the end of the third cohort year. The first cohort of Rising Stars Schools under the Nevada ESSA Plan were identified in 2017. Therefore, this year's Rising Stars Schools list includes both schools identified this year and in 2017.

¹ The Nevada School Performance Framework is the annual school rating system used for all public K-12 schools in Nevada. Scores and ratings are calculated annually by the Nevada Department of Education.

Column Header Descriptions

District: The school district of the identified school. Charter schools that are sponsored by the State Public Charter School Authority are listed as “SPCSA” while school district-sponsored charter schools are listed under their school district sponsor.

School Name: The name of the identified school.

2018 Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) Category: The Comprehensive Support and Improvement criteria the school met in order to be identified. To be identified as a CSI school, a school had to meet at least one of the following criteria: are in the lowest 5% of schools based on their Index Score; received a 1-Star rating on the Nevada School Performance Framework; or a high school with a graduation rate below 67%. *Schools identified as part of the 2017 cohort that did not meet the CSI criteria in 2018 will not have a category listed. Instead it will say “N/A”.*

Cohort (consecutive years meeting criteria): The **Cohort** is the year the school was initially identified as a Rising Stars School. The **Consecutive Years Meeting Criteria** indicates the number of consecutive years the school has met at least one of the following criteria: are in the lowest 5% of schools based on their Index Score; received a 1-Star rating on the Nevada School Performance Framework; or a high school with a graduation rate below 67%. *School identified as a part of the 2017 cohort that did not meet the CSI criteria in 2018 will not have consecutive years listed.*

Title I: Schools eligible for Title I funding are marked “Y” for yes or “N” for no.

Alternate Performance Framework: Schools participating in the Alternate Performance Framework marked “Y” for yes or “N” for no.
