# 2024 Nevada Educational Choice Scholarship Program Report

## Program Description and Requirements

NRS 388D.270 defines the Nevada Educational Choice Scholarship Program (often referred to as Opportunity Scholarship). This program allows a student whose family has a household income not more than 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to apply for a scholarship from an approved Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO).

NRS 388D.280 requires each scholarship organization which receives a donation, gift or grant of money described to provide an annual report to the Nevada Department of Education (NDE) on or before January 31 of each year.

NAC 388D.070 directs NDE to annually submit a report to the Nevada Governor, the Director of the Nevada Legislative Counsel Bureau, and the Nevada State Board of Education, which provides the information reported to NDE by the registered SGOs. This report fulfills that requirement. NAC 388D.070 was amended in 2024 to expand the deadline for the report from March 30 of each year to July 31.

## Nevada Educational Choice Scholarship Eligibility

Students whose family income does not exceed 300% of the federal poverty guidelines are eligible for the Nevada Educational Choice Scholarship.

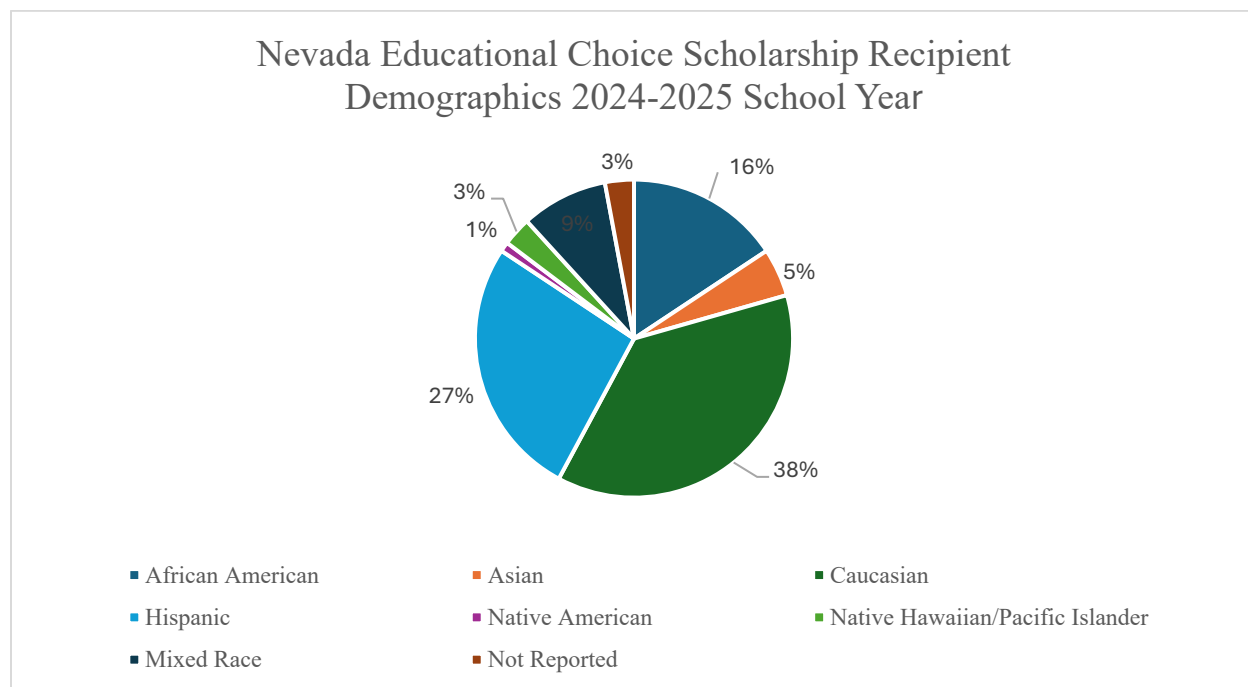

## Assessment

NAC 388D.110 requires schools to assess students who participate in the Educational Choice Scholarship annually. This report reflects growth and assessment data from the 2021-22 school year through the 2023-24 school year. Schools are required to report their data once a year, and they do so with their fourth quarterly report in June.

NDE analyzed student growth, loss, or maintenance on four different series of tests: the Iowa Assessment, Measures of Academic Progress (MAP), Terra Nova, and the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/SAT battery of assessments. Progress was measured year over year with the same assessment. Students took the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, PSAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), and the SAT. Different sub-tests were not compared. These assessments were the most utilized by schools whose students participated in the Educational Choice Scholarship program. Only those scores of students who participated in the scholarship program are reported. Progress was also measured over two years, noting those students who made progress for two consecutive years. Assessments for the two prior years, 2019-20 and 2020-21, were suspended due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Scores were also aggregated by race/ethnicity and grade levels across all assessments.

The disparity in the number of scores reported in English/Language Arts (ELA) and Math was due to absences or scores that were believed inaccurate or disputed. Scores were reported in ELA and Math for all but a handful of students.

There are 21 approved normed assessments from which schools can choose to fulfill the assessment requirement. Schools may assess their students in kindergarten through grade 2 with a non-normed

assessment that NDE approves. The PSAT/SAT series of assessments was the only high school series that produced results year-over-year. Although some schools used the ACT series of tests (Pre-ACT 8/9, Pre-ACT, and ACT), there were no year-over-year comparisons since students either took different assessments each year in high school or no data from the previous year was available. Various subsets of the ACT assessments cannot be compared.

It should be noted that private schools are not required to follow NDE's Test Security Procedures; however, many have chosen to do so. The Department sent out a survey on testing procedures to administrators whose schools are represented in this report; 81% of private school administrators whose schools are represented in this report responded to the survey. One school has closed since the end of the school year, but its data was included. Of those who responded, 64% reported that their school adhered to NDE's test security procedures. Of those who did not follow NDE's procedures, 28% of the administrators reported that their school followed the testing procedures detailed by the assessments themselves without deviation. The remaining 8% reported they follow the assessment testing procedures that pertain to them and have their own additional testing procedures to ensure test validity.
