Strategic Improvement Plan Alignment

Goal 2:

All students have access to effective educators

Input: Expanded teacher recognition efforts, including through elevating State Teacher of the Year (STOY), Superintendent's Teacher Advisory Cabinet (STAC), and educational personnel awards

Output: Increase in application submission rates for STOY, STAC, and educational personnel awards by 10% annually

Outcome: Increase in educator preparation program enrollees and qualified mentors identified through recognition programs

Application Process

- Self nominations and peer nominations
- Applications available on Teacher of the Year website:
 - Submitted electronically

2021: 72 Nominations and 16 Applications (45% increase) 2022: 76 Nominations and 20 Applications (25% increase)

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Selection Process

- Committee of previous NV Teacher of the Year recipients individually reviewed applications
 - Rubric aligned with Council of Chief State School Officers (CCSSO) National Expectations
- Phone screenings and panel interviews conducted
- Five candidates receiving the highest scores were submitted to Superintendent Ebert
- Superintendent Ebert makes an anonymous selection of the NV Teacher of the Year from redacted applications.
