## **Offices Were Asked for Input on:**

### Frequency

- How often does the office use the information in the report (never, rarely, sometimes, very often, or always)?
- Is the current schedule for report collection the right frequency (too frequent, not enough, or correct as is)?

#### **Use of Reports**

- encouraged to share the report that collected similar information.

#### **Opportunities for Elimination, Streamlining, or Consolidation**

were encouraged to give suggestions on ways to streamline or consolidate the reports.



How does the office use the report? Offices were asked to choose from a range of options, and some offices added their own answers.


### Notes/Suggestions

rrently collected annually. The responding NDE office suggested, "We uld get rid of ALL other reports and keep this one. To that end, either we uld make this biennial [...] or we could keep it annual and have the CSR combined with this report (only once per year)."

e responding NDE office suggested that the CSR reports can be nsolidated into one annual report that collects all CSR information.

rrently collected at least once every six months. Both responding NDE ces suggested that it should be collected annually.

is report is currently collected annually. The responding NDE office ggested that it should be collected every other year, prior to the legislative ssion, to inform funding requests.





## Input on Elimination, Streamlining, and Consolidation

### **Consider Eliminating (see Table 2 in accompanying memo)**

Based on input from NDE staff, 26 reports should be considered for elimination.

#### **Streamlining or Consolidation**

- Based on input from NDE staff, 22 reports should be considered for streamlining or consolidation.
- The WestEd/APA team will meet with NDE offices to discuss their responses and create specific action step recommendations for each report.

#### **Additional Input**

- NDE staff indicated that there are 18 reports that, although rarely or never used, should be kept as is or kept with small modifications. There were no responses provided for 48 reports, or the responses were unclear.
- The WestEd/APA team will meet with NDE offices to discuss their responses and create specific action step recommendations for each report.

### Recommendation: Begin by focusing on reports that NDE offices believe can be eliminated.

## Challenge of Aligning Data, CSF, and Legislative Calendars

- Some data elements are not available until January
- CSF meets for the last time in December
- Legislative session begins the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in February in odd years
- A November report will have a hybrid of data that is 5 months old and 17 months old.
- A March report will have data that is current through the prior June (7 months old).





### **Choices for Summary Report Timing**

- **One comprehensive report in March** •
- An early release report in November with a Spring supplement in March
