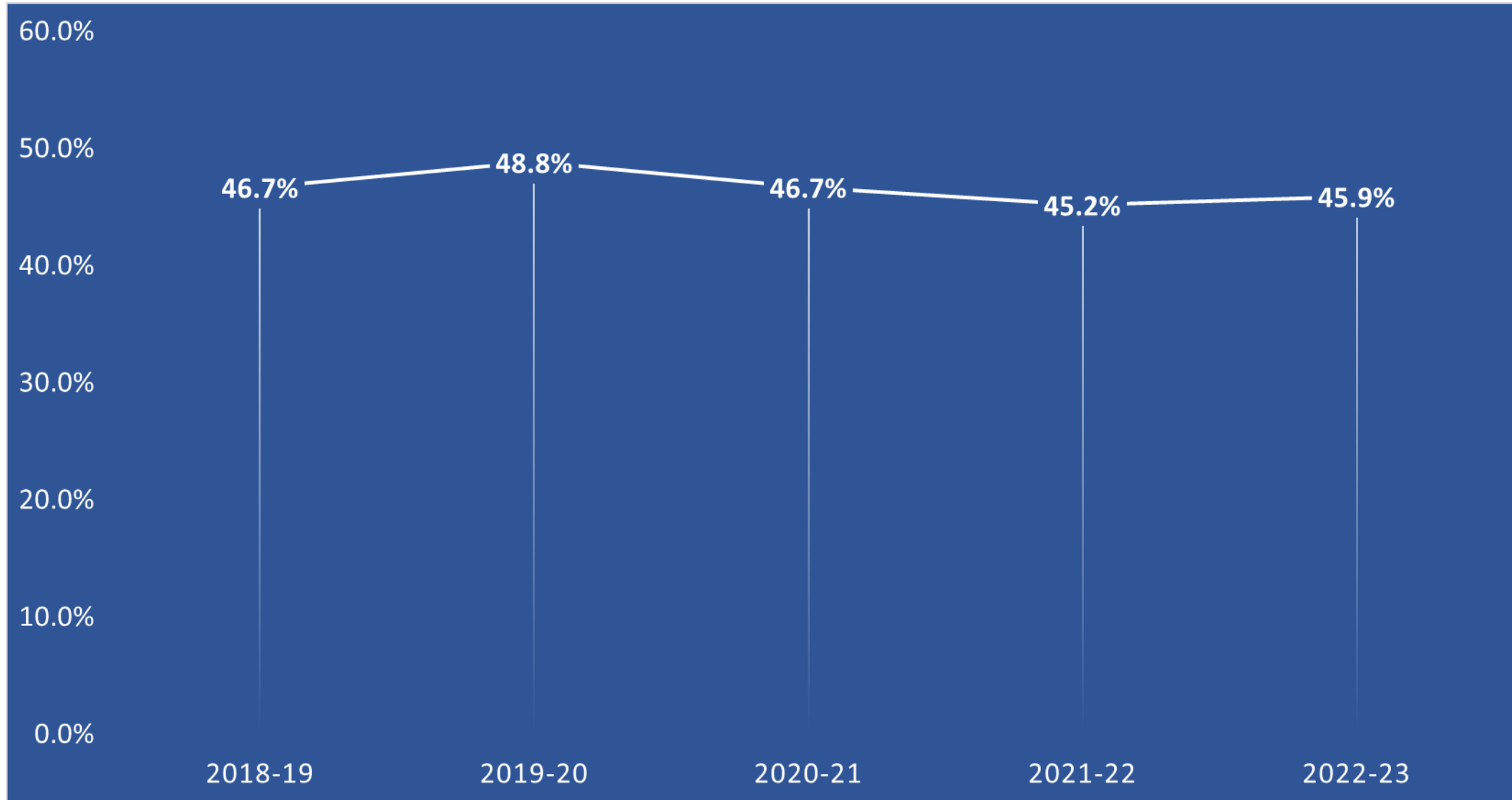

ACT

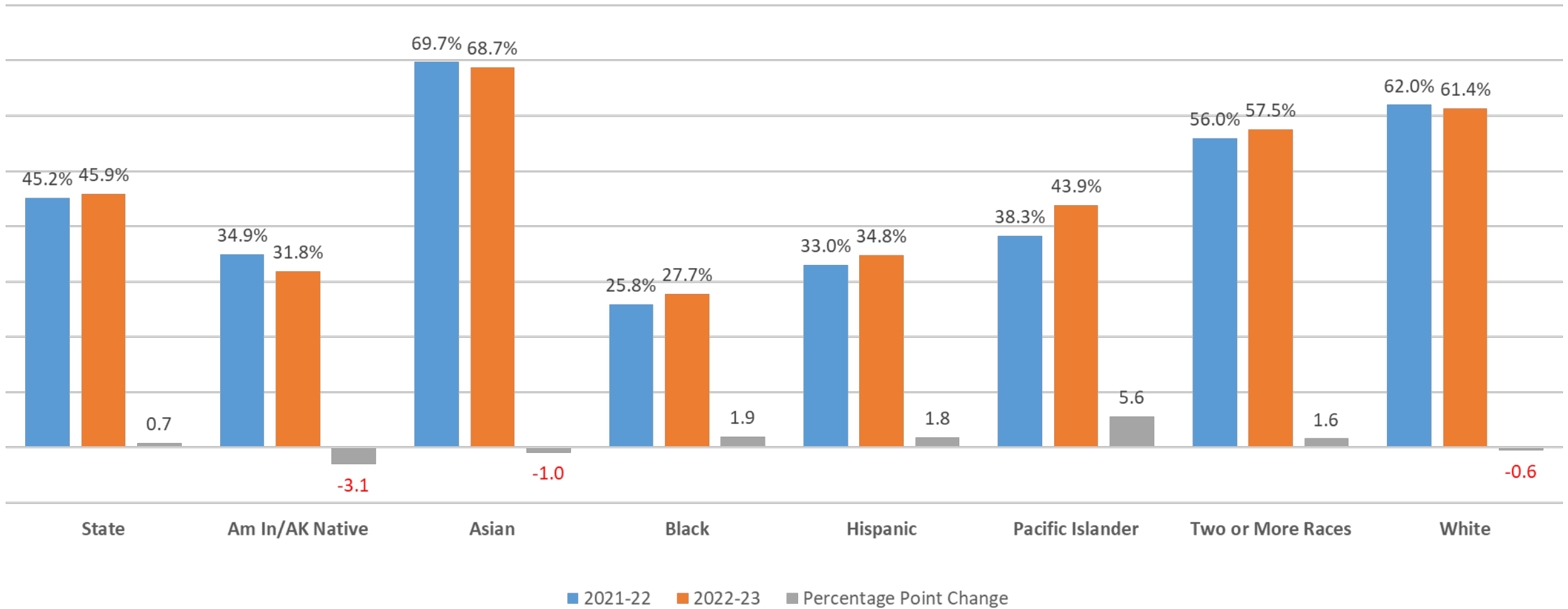
- ACT is Nevada's federally reported high school ELA and Math assessment.

ACT ELA Proficiency Rates: 5-Year Trend



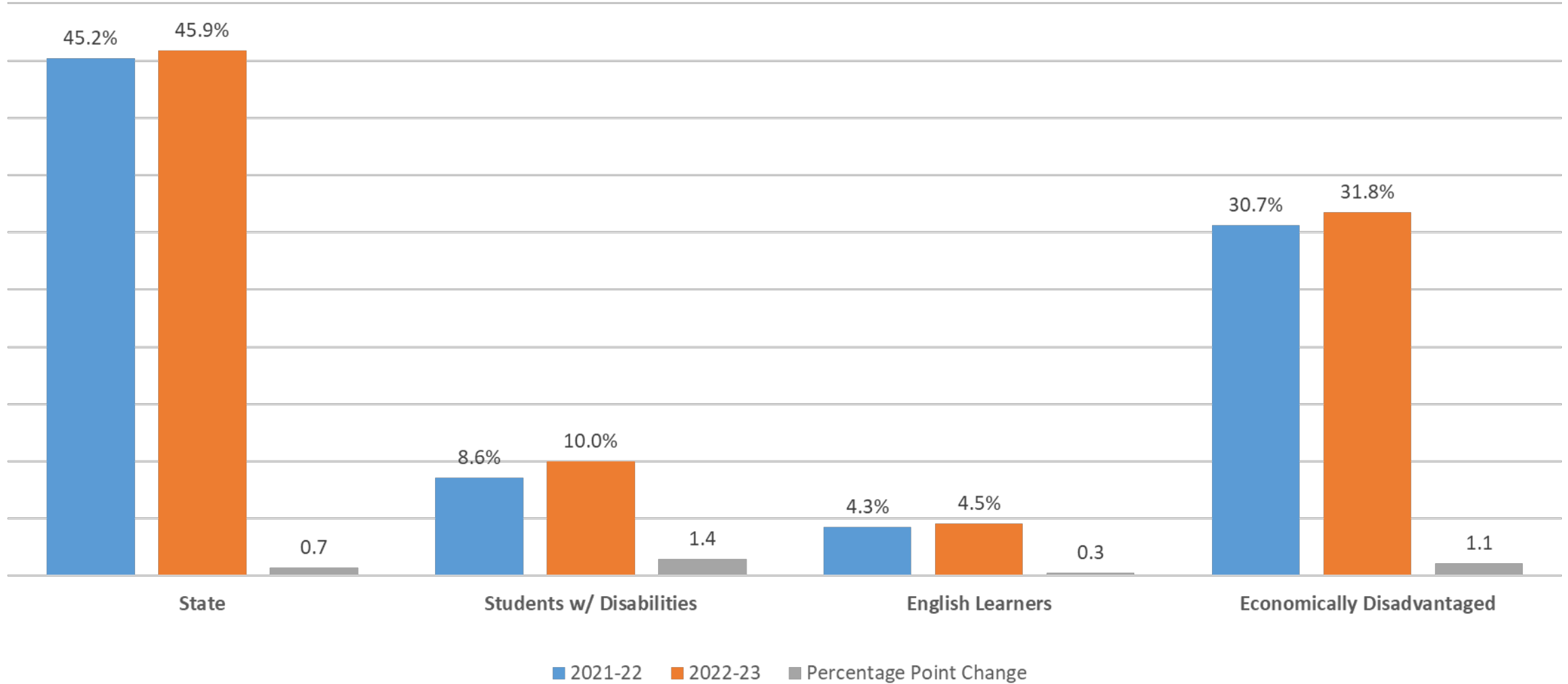

Race/Ethnicity Comparison: SY 2021-22 and SY 2022-23

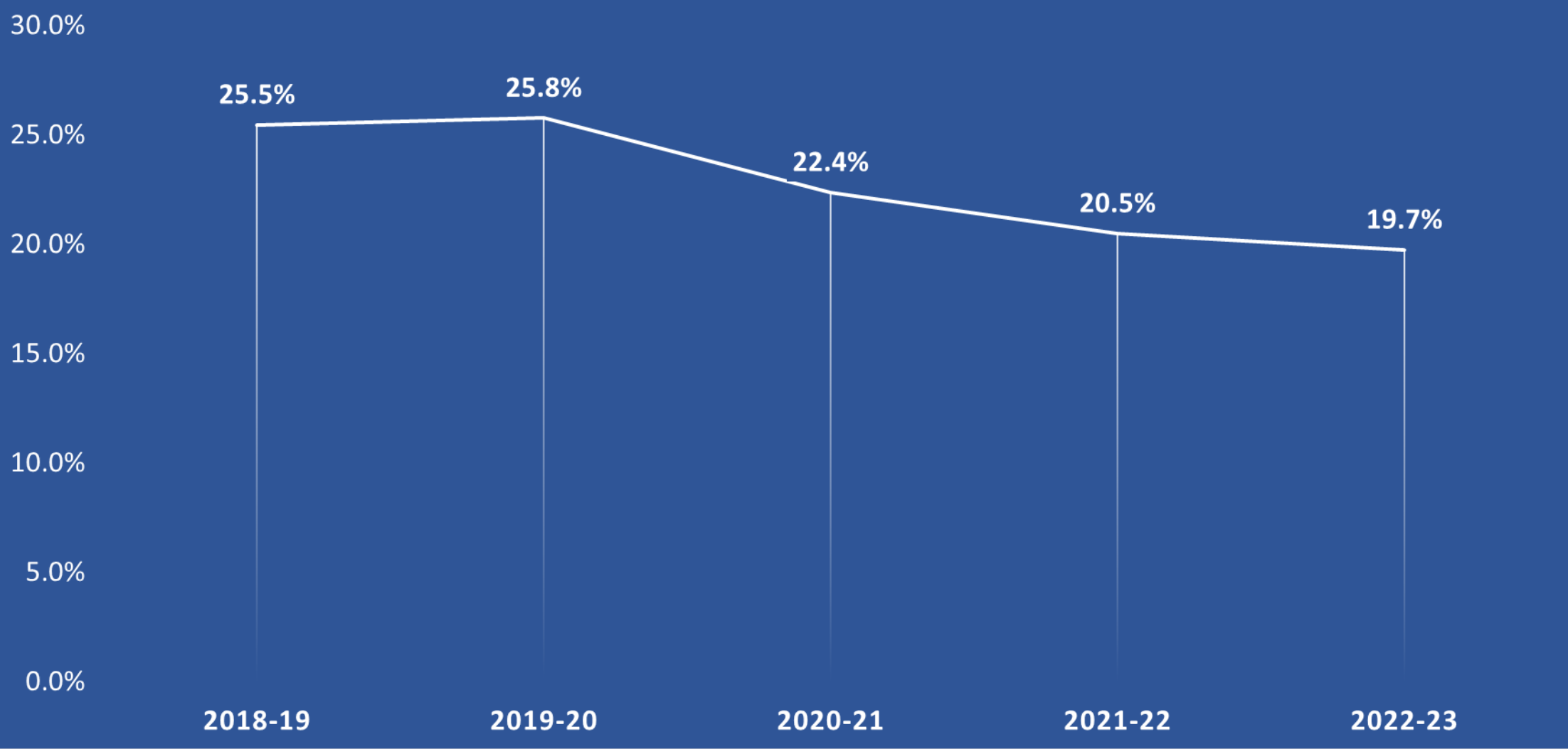


ACT ELA Proficiency

Student Groups Comparison: SY 2021-22 and SY 2022-23

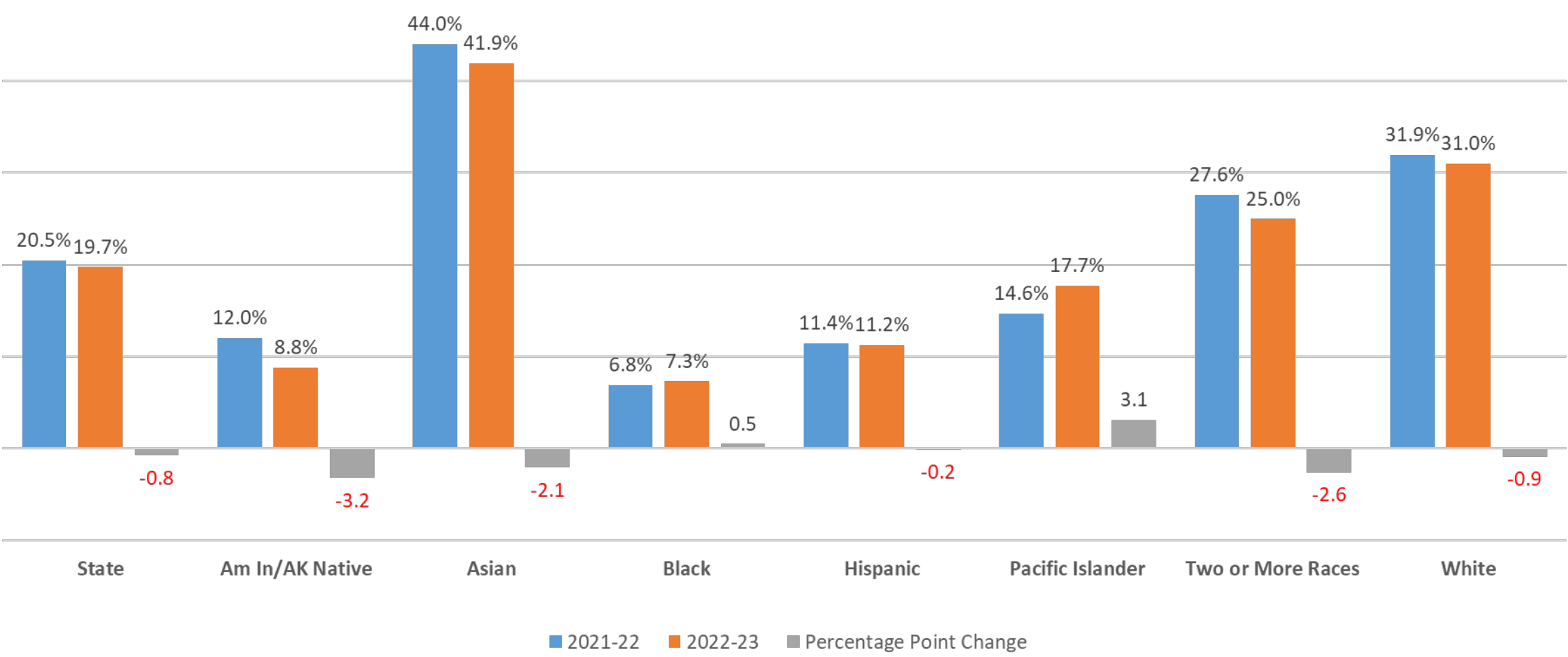


ACT Math Proficiency Rates: 5-Year Trend



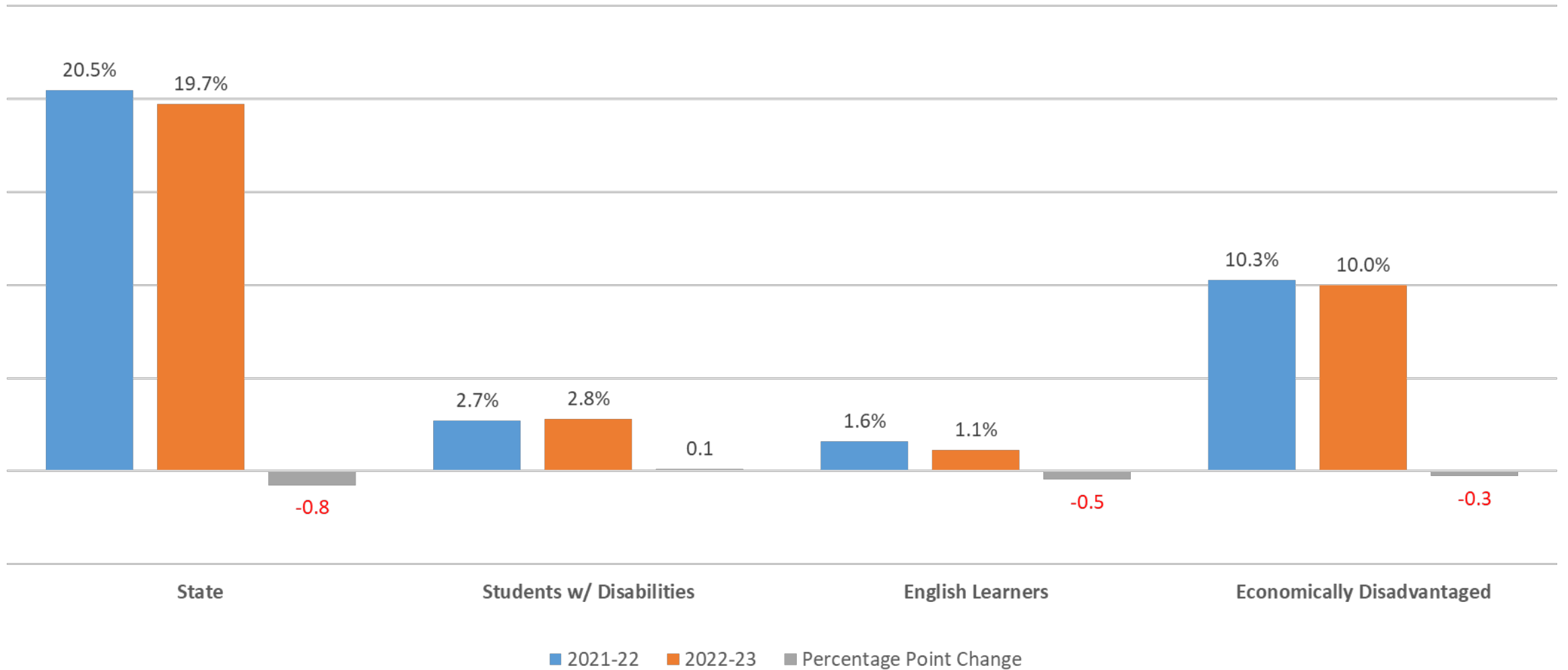
