Private School Analysis

School Name: Little Lites Christian Learning Center, Washoe County

Background: Little Lites Christian Learning Center's mission is to provide a faith-based, engaging, and hands-on curriculum that prepares students for their next stage of development—spiritually, emotionally, cognitively, and relationally. The kindergarten and first-grade programs serve as an alternative to public school, utilizing the Abeka homeschool curriculum to support individualized academic growth. With intentionally small class sizes, students receive the focused attention necessary to foster success. By the conclusion of the kindergarten program, students demonstrate foundational skills in reading and basic mathematics.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Little Lites Christian Learning Center for a provisional license from November 12, 2025, through November 12, 2027. Little Lites Christian Learning Center has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.
