School Name: Faith Academy, Washoe County

Background: Faith Academy first developed as a homeschool collective, but now desires to expand into an exempt private school. Whereas the school relied on family volunteers, it is now looking to add paid teachers. The school will use the Abeka curriculum for all subjects.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Faith Academy for an initial provisional license for two years from September 6, 2023, through September 6, 2025. Faith Academy reported that the school is working to complete statutory and regulatory requirements for initial licensing by September 6, 2023. The provisional license will be issued when final compliance measures are complete.

Background: Christo Rey St. Viator College Preparatory Academy educates young people of limited economic means to become men and women of faith, purpose, and service. Financial need is the first criterion for admission and is decided on a case-by-case basis using the Cristo Rey Network Guidelines. The school is part of the only network of high schools in the country that integrates four years of rigorous college preparatory academics with four years of mandatory professional work experience through its Corporate Work Study Program.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Cristo Rey St. Viator Las Vegas College Preparatory for a license for two years from August 31, 2023, through August 31, 2025. Cristo Rey St. Viator Las Vegas College Preparatory has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.
