

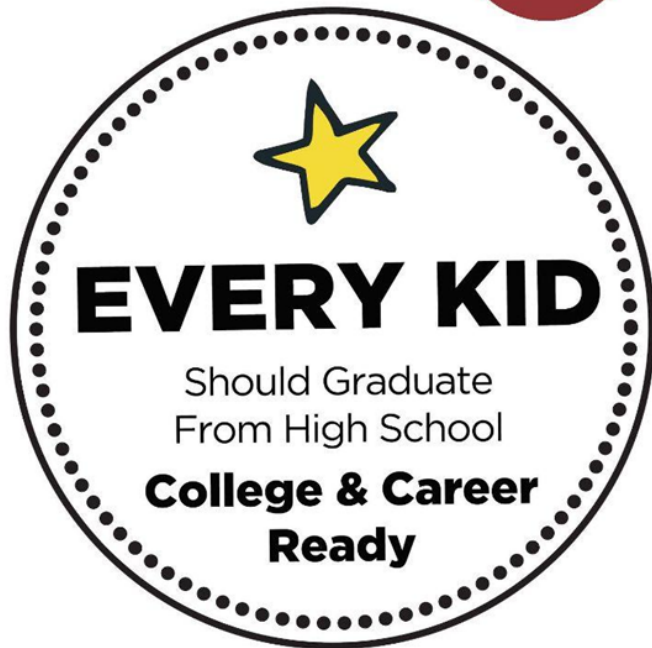

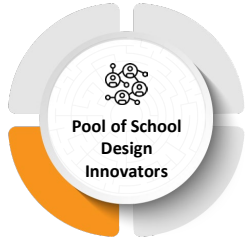

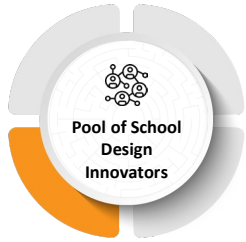
What Is It?

- Leadership development to build mindsets and skills in service of advancing equity in education in Clark County

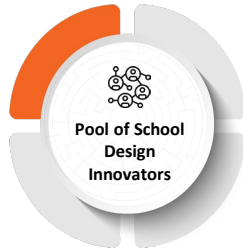

- 3-stage fellowship: Explore, Cultivate, and Prepare to Launch

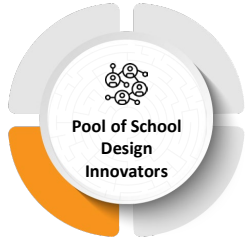
Who Should Apply?

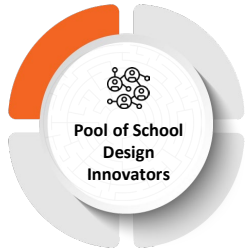
What Is It?

- Identifies as a Black and/or Latino male

- As a coalition, the cohort can build movements that influence, innovate, and transform the education space in their communities

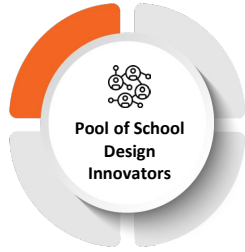
Who Should Apply?

School Accelerator

What Is It?

- A cohort experience for principals and their leadership teams to establish multi-year strategic plans with clear goals, metrics, and capacity-building among leaders

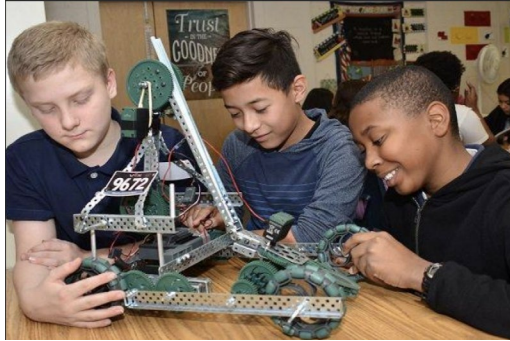
Who Should Apply?

- School principals looking to strengthen the school's academic program and supporting systems, who have:
 - A commitment to racial equity
 - A demonstrated track record of leadership
 - A deep understanding of their own strengths and identity
 - The vision and drive to bring forth a more equitable future of learning





Accelerate



- Builds leader ability to develop the capacity of a team to lead a community through iterative cycles of development in service of long-term, sustainable change
- A structured pathway for high-potential current or future school leaders to articulate, pilot, and implement their big ideas.
- Current providers: Bellwether, Transcend, Attuned Education Partners, Design to EdRupt



Propel



- A residency experience where high-potential current or future school leaders more intensely study a school model.
- Leaders develop a business plan for a new public charter school, or placement in a Clark County School District setting to improve student outcomes.
