Council Responsibilities

NRS 391A.135

Council shall

- Adopt uniform standards used in the review and approval of training to be provided,
- In cooperation with Office of Parental Involvement and Family Engagement establish statewide program concerning effective parental involvement and family engagement,
- Coordinate dissemination of information concerning training programs, and
- Disseminate information to the regional training programs concerning innovative and effective methods to provide professional development

Council Responsibilities (cont.)

NRS 391A.135

Council shall

- Conduct long-range planning concerning professional development needs,
- Adopt uniform procedures and criteria to report the evaluation of programs,
- Review and recommend any necessary revisions to the 5-year plan prepared by each program, and
- Review and recommend any necessary revisions to annual report prepared by the governing body of each program.

Council Responsibilities (cont.)

NRS 391A.135

Council shall

- Ensure the governing body of each program considers the plans to improve student achievement for the public schools within the program jurisdiction and the plan to improve student achievement prepared by the State Board and is guided by those plans, and
- Coordinate with the Office of Parental Involvement and Family Engagement in carrying out the duties of the office.

Budget Responsibilities

NRS 391A.135

- Review and approve budgets for each of the programs
- Review and approve budget revisions
 - Budget revisions are subject to the provisions of NRS.353.220
 - May require IFC approval as well
- Review and approve biennial budget submissions
