The meeting is open to the public and will be held at the Legislative Building in Carson City, NV, and at the Grant Sawyer Building in Las Vegas, NV. The meeting will be live-streamed and will allow call-ins for public comment as well as in person. Kathleen Galland-Collins mentioned that NDE intends to invite stakeholder groups to the LCE meeting to provide public comments to support their work.
