

Special - Ages 3-21 Audiological Services

NAC 391.223

- 1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: General License Requirements
- 2. Hold a valid Certificate of Clinical Competence as an audiologist issued by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA); or
- 3. Hold a master's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university in audiology; or
- 4. Hold a master's or more advanced degree and have completed the following:
 - A. Three hundred (300) hours of supervised clinical experience in audiology or speech-language pathology
 - B. Complete sixty (60) semester credits in coursework to include normal development, function and use of speech and language or hearing, including, but not limited to, the management of disorders of speech or hearing and the legal, professional, and ethical practices of audiology or speech-language pathology. At least twenty-four (24) semester credits, not including credits earned for a thesis or dissertation, must be earned in coursework directly related to audiology or speech-language pathology.

This endorsement is not required to provide audiological services to pupils who are 3 to 21 years of age.
