Bilingual Education**

1. Bachelor's or more advanced degree with a major in bilingual education; and
2. Hold a valid early childhood education, elementary, middle school/junior high, secondary, special, or special education teaching license and have completed:
  - A. A bilingual program of preparation for teaching pupils who are identified as having limited proficiency in English which has been approved by the Board; or
  - B. Complete twelve (12) semester credits of coursework to include theories for the acquisition of a second language with the remaining coursework in at least three (3) of the following areas:
    1. Methods of teaching language arts or reading in the native language
    2. Methods of teaching math, science, and social studies in the native language
    3. Testing and evaluating pupils of a second language in English and the native language
    4. Development of curriculum, materials, and teaching methods for bilingual education
    5. Native language and culture; or
    6. Bilingual education, history, philosophy, and theory
