

Nevada's CCR Assessment Stakeholder Survey

Introduction

The Department of Education anticipates releasing a Request for Procurement (RFP) for the College and Career Readiness (CCR) Assessment in late 2022, early 2023. Nevada Revised Statutes 390.610 and Nevada Administrative Code 390.210 state that the Nevada State Board of Education must select an 11th grade college and career readiness assessment. Each pupil must participate in the selected assessment to receive a Nevada diploma. Nevada's current CCR Assessment is the ACT. The CCR Assessment is federally required and is reported as Nevada's assessment of mathematics and English Language Arts for students in high school; therefore, the CCR Assessment is mandated to meet specific content, validity, and reliability guidelines. The Department is seeking feedback from stakeholders around a CCR Assessment to inform the drafting of the RFP and the subsequent assessment that will be chosen. Upon the selection of a vendor through the RFP Process, the CCR Assessment that is chosen would likely be implemented in the 2023-24 school year. This survey is designed to gather feedback from stakeholders and will close on Friday, November 11, 2022 at 11:59pm.
