Dear Superintendent Jara:

In the information request letter regarding Clark County School District's (CCSD) full compliance of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 388G.500 – 388G.810, dated December 28, 2020, you were asked to **provide each school's individual plan to spend their carryover dollars in FY21**. Pursuant to NRS 388G.580, each large school district (CCSD) is **required** to cooperate with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction in carrying out the provisions of NRS 388G.500 – 388G.810 inclusive, including without limitation, by providing any financial or other information that the Nevada Department of Education (NDE) requests and any information needed to ensure that the intent of the provisions of NRS 388G.500 – 388G.810 inclusive are carried out.

- With respect to this request, please provide a sample of at least 20 schools' individual plans by March 18, 2021 and provide NDE with principal contact information of all schools with reported carryover funds identified in Attachment 8 in your letter dated December 15, 2020. NDE will use the principal contact information to solicit any or all individual school plans related to fiscal year 2021 carryover dollars.

In the letter dated December 28, 2020, you were also asked to **provide a breakdown by subject/licensure area of the applicants that have completed the vetting process and are ready for hire, and to indicate if there are job openings for their subject/licensure area.**

- The response that you were unable to produce the reports to fulfill this request is not acceptable. Provide the requested information by March 18, 2021 as outlined in the letter dated January 7, 2021.
