Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Amendments to NAC Chapter 391.057 – Provisional licensure: Qualification; authorized employment; term of validity; automatic invalidity; reinstatement and Repeal of NAC 391.0573 – Provisional licensure: Areas of instruction to teach certain pupils; categories of instruction to teach special education to certain pupils, NAC 391.0575 – Provisional licensure: Requirements to apply for initial license to teach secondary education or to teach pupils enrolled in early childhood education or kindergarten and grades 1 through 12 in specific area, and NAC 391.0577 – Provisional licensure: Requirements to apply for initial license to teach elementary education, to teach pupils in program of early childhood education or in

The proposed changes to NAC 391.057 would remove competency testing for this alternative license. This license is not a standard license and testing would still be required for a standard license. The proposed changes to NAC 391.057 would also allow a member of the Armed Forces, spouse, or veteran to apply for an initial license if they completed an ARL program in another State. NAC 391.0573, NAC 391.0575, and NAC 391.0577 would be repealed. Possible action may or may not include moving these proposed regulation changes to Public Hearing.

The coursework requirement in lieu of the math exam would be removed. The pathway to obtain an additional endorsement with an exam would be removed. The proposed changes to NAC 391.120 would remove the pathway to obtain an additional endorsement with an exam. The proposed changes to 391.125 would require the holder of this license to complete coursework and an exam to hold this license. The proposed changes to NAC 391.xxx would create a pathway by exam for certain license holders to obtain an additional endorsement in a recognized area of teaching for middle school education or secondary education. Possible action may or may not include moving these proposed regulation changes and proposed regulation to Public Hearing.
