CSF's Prior Recommendations: Auxiliary Services

- CSF meeting September 17, 2021
 - Agenda item #5 motions approved
 - Recommendation Use of the four-year average of actual costs for transportation and food services
 - Recommendation Use a similar "hold harmless" type of adjustment for each of the 4 years of transportation and food services costs that is used for the average daily enrollment for payment purposes

CSF's Prior Recommendations: Extend Auxiliary Services funding to Charter Schools

- CSF meeting September 17, 2021
 - Agenda item #6 motions approved
 - Recommendation Charter and University schools be included in the auxiliary services allocation calculations
 - Recommendation Charter and University schools receive the same inflation factors as districts
 - Recommendation The average total should be based on the number of years that the school has supporting transportation and food services data
 - Example: If the school only had two years of auxiliary services data, a two-year average would be applied for that charter and university school

Auxiliary Services Options for Inflation Rates

- PCFP approved inflation rate
 - Included in the legislatively approved Pupil-Centered Funding Plan (PCFP)
- Education specific inflation rate
 - Based on national data
 - Private schools only
- Industry specific inflation rate
 - Transportation inflation rate
 - Based on national data
 - Combines Consumer Price Index (CPI) expenditure categories
 - Gasoline (all types)
 - Motor vehicle parts and equipment
 - Motor vehicle maintenance and repair
 - Motor vehicle insurance
 - Not education specific
 - Food at elementary and secondary school specific inflation rate
 - Based on national data
 - Private schools only

Auxiliary Services

Options for Inflation Rates - continued

- Western region specific inflation rate
 - Based on the western regional data
 - All items, less food and energy
 - Unadjusted index data
 - Not education specific
- Nevada specific CPI
 - Based on Nevada data
 - Based on state and area employment, hours, and earnings
 - Combines the following industries:
 - Government
 - Education and Health Services
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities
 - Unadjusted index data

Auxiliary Services Recommendation

NDE recommendation

- Apply a consistent inflation factor to all funding tiers of the Pupil-Centered Funding Plan
 - Nevada specific inflation factor inclusive of
 - Inflation rate of 1.88%
 - Government CPI data set
 - Education and Health Services CPI data set
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities CPI data set
 - Aligns with the Nevada Cost of Education Index (NCEI) recommended by the CSF.
