

Special - (Grade level is specific to the grade level of the base teaching license) English Language Acquisition and Development (ELAD)

NAC 391.237

To receive an endorsement in English Language Acquisition and Development (ELAD):

- 1. Hold a valid early childhood education, elementary, middle school/junior high school, secondary, special education, or special teaching license, excluding Business and Industry; and
- 2. Complete three (3) semester credits of coursework in each of the following areas of study:
 - A. Language acquisition theory and English language development practices
 - B. Methods and curriculum for teaching English learners
 - C. Assessment and evaluation of English learners; and
- 3. Complete two (2) semester credits of coursework in one of the following areas of study:
 - A. Policies, critical issues and best practices for English learners in prekindergarten and elementary school, or
 - B. Policies, critical issues and best practices for English learners in secondary school; and
- 4. Complete one (1) semester credit of practicum, which must include at least twenty-five (25) hours of experience working in the classroom

To receive an endorsement as a Specialist in English Language Acquisition and Development (ELAD):

- 1. Complete the requirements for an ELAD endorsement as described above; and
- 2. Complete three (3) semester credits of coursework in each of the following areas of study:
 - A. Foundations in education in cultural and linguistic diversity; and
 - B. Cultural and linguistic diversity program leadership
