Equitable Services Allocations 2018-2019

Since the initial passage of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA)*, private school students and teachers have been eligible to participate in certain federal education programs. The *ESEA* includes separate provisions governing equitable services for eligible private school students, teachers, and other educational personnel, and families under Title I and programs covered under Title VIII, Part F, Subpart 1-Private Schools: Equitable Services for Private School Students, Teachers, and Other Educational Personnel.

Programs Requiring Equitable Services

Equitable services requirements for non-public/ private schools apply to programs under §1117 and §8501 of the ESEA as amended by ESSA:

- Title I, Part A-Improving Basic Programs
- Title I, Part C-Migrant Education
- Title II, Part A-Supporting Effective Instruction
- Title III, Part A-English Language Acquisition
- Title IV, Part A-Student Support and Academic Enrichment
- Title IV, Part B- 21st Century Community Learning Center

2018-2019 SY Allocations for Participating Schools

The public school district is required to contact all non-profit private schools within their district in an effort to consult and determine if the private school would like to participate in equitable services. Once a private school agrees to participate, the school district collects information on eligible students to determine the amount of funds available. The table below includes the amount of equitable services available for each district with participating private schools. The table only includes Title I, Part A and Title II, Part A because no private schools chose to participate in the other remaining federal programs.
