Assembly Bill 3 Funds


Eureka County School District will use AB 3 funds to restock necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) and cleaning supplies

- We have concerns about the capacity of our local broadband internet access and are hoping our COVID-19 transmission risk indicators remain low in order to maintain in-person learning


Challenges


- Additional time and staff requirements in order to safely bring students back on campus

- Quarantine procedures for staff and students














Highlights
