Review of Executive Order 2023-003



Order Freezing the Issuance of New Regulations and Requiring a Review of Existing Regulations by All Executive Branch Agencies, Departments, Boards and Commissions

Enacted on January 12, 2023

May 1 – Report due related to Sections 1-3

Review of Executive Order 2023-003 continued



Section 1: Report detailing how regulations subject to enforcement can be streamlined, clarified, reduced, or otherwise improved

Section 2: Provide a list of not less than ten regulations recommended for removal

Section 3: Hold a public hearing

Section 4: No new regulations

Sections 5: Exemptions to section 4

Status of Stakeholder Input



As of April 3: 39 submissions

- 20 to streamline, clarify, or otherwise improve
- 3 to reduce/remove
- 16 to remove


