



General License Requirements

These requirements apply to all licenses unless otherwise indicated below or on the individual endorsement requirements.

Exams

The exam requirements for the Nevada Department of Education may be found on the page for the [Nevada Department of Education Praxis Requirements](#) page.

The Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators:

Reading (5713) and

Writing (5723) and

Mathematics (5733) **OR**

Combined test (5752) if you wish to take all three at the same time.

Principles of Learning and Teaching

Middle School/Junior High School licenses require Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades 5-9 (5623)

Secondary licenses require Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades 7-12 (5624)

Special Education and Special licenses *may* require Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades K-6 (5622) **OR** Grades 7-12 (5624). Please refer to the [Nevada ETS site](#) and locate the desired area of licensure.

Subject Area Exams

Please refer to the [Nevada ETS site](#). If the endorsement area is listed, the subject area exam is required. If it is not listed, it is not required.

Parental Involvement and Family Engagement (PIFE) course work

You can view a list of approved courses on by going to the [Nevada Department of Education Family Engagement Approved Courses](#) page. We **DO NOT accept** any other courses which are not on the course matrix.

Special Education course work

Three (3) semester credits in a course of study regarding education or curricular adaptation for pupils with disabilities. If you are applying for a Special Education license, an additional course is not required.

Provisional Licenses

A provisional license may be issued with the following missing requirements: any exams, PIFE course work, and/or six (6) or less semester credits of course work per endorsement (not including student teaching credits).

Multicultural Education course work (Renewal Requirement)

Effective as of July 2019, all initial licensees will be required to complete at least three (3) semester or forty-five (45) in-service hours of course work in Multicultural Education in order to renew an initial license.
