

Special - Grades K-12 Great Basin Native American Language

NAC 391.233

- 1. Hold a high school diploma or its equivalent; and
- 2. Six (6) semester credits of coursework to include the following:
 - A. Professional education and teaching methodology; or
 - B. The study of Native American languages; and
- 3. Be certified as a fluent speaker of the language that the person proposes to teach by:
 - A. A council of a tribe of Native Americans who speak that language; or
 - B. A qualified official of a university or college

An applicant for a Great Basin Native Language endorsement is not required to meet the requirements of the Praxis series tests.

NOTE: A person who does not meet the qualifications required by numbers 1 and 2 above but does meet the qualifications required by number 3 may teach a course in a Great Basin Native American language without an endorsement if a licensed teacher is present in the classroom during the instruction. Written documentation of the person's certification as a fluent speaker of the language he proposes to teach must be provided to the Department before he/she may begin teaching.
