Plan II- Rural School

Students receive instruction Monday-Thursday. Due to low enrollment numbers, in Plan II, all social distancing and safety requirements are feasible without compromising the traditional schedule. Teachers maintain the Friday PD schedule as noted in the calendar.

Plan III - Traditional School*

- Full return to traditional school with safety protocols in place (normal operations)
 - Regular lunches, transportation, recess schedules, and school schedules
- Enhanced Safety Precautions Implemented
 - Masks/face shields optional
 - Hand sanitizer available
 - Student/Staff/Parent Self-Screening Procedures
 - Visitors limited, by appointment
 - Students and employees trained in all areas of social distancing, handwashing, respiratory etiquette, and mask use to mitigate exposure

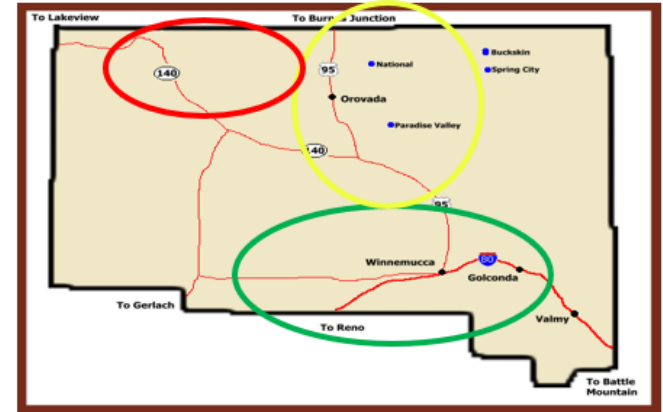

- \$283,877.46 - Dedicated all funds towards contracting with Edgenuity to provide Rigorous and Relevant High Quality Distance Learning instruction for all HCSD students.
- Supports Distance Learning needs for students under the Hybrid Model
- Provides High Quality instruction meeting State Standards for students in Full Distance Education

Preparedness - Connectivity/Device Need Status

- Humboldt County – 9,600 Sq Miles
 - Denio – 100 miles – Red
 - McDermitt – 72 miles – Yellow
- Green – Winnemucca Area
 - T- Mobile Hot Spots
 - Mesh Network
- Yellow – Rural/Remote Rural
 - Verizon Hot Spots
- Red – Remote Rural (Denio and Kings River)
 - PBS – Raspberry Pi type solution



Challenges

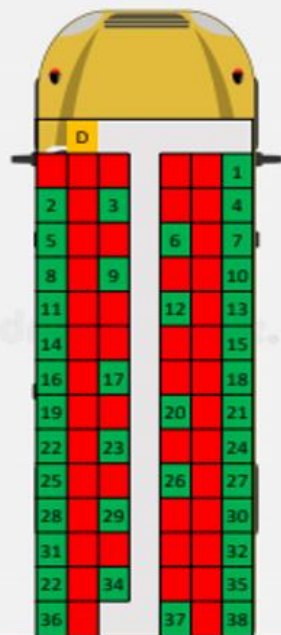
- Transportation
- Loss of Enrollment Due to COVID Restrictions
 - **204** students/families have opted for Home School as a result of COVID
 - Potential loss of 1.1 million in revenue
 - **360** students have opted for fully Distance Education
 - Initial thought that such would equate to 4th quarter instruction

Transportation Models – 84 Seat Bus



38 of 84 seats – 45%



45% (38) – Limited PD - high back seats provide partial partition – one student to a seat with some two to a seat

50% (42) – Limited PD - high back seats provide partial partition - one student to a seat with some two to a seat

42 of 84 seats – 50%
