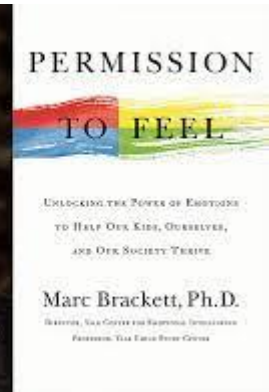
- Provoke curiosity, creativity, and a sense of wonder within the K-12 education system
