The Educational Center utilizes the Apex Learning system, a nationally accredited digital curriculum to support the residents' progress.

Students who participate in this program can obtain dual diplomas, and they can also join an American university curriculum via concurrent enrollment. The dual diploma program allows students to receive a U.S. high school diploma while completing their secondary school diploma. It helps students to enter American universities effectively and quickly.

**Recommendation:** It is recommended that the State Board approve the change of operations from SinoUSA to Wharton School on behalf of World Cultures and Languages Institute, Inc. for the remaining term of its license, March 1, 2021, through March 31, 2023. World Cultures and Languages Institute, Inc has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.
