- Category 2: Top 40% for proficiency target in ELA and Math or top 15% for growth proficiency in ELA or Math (SBAC scores) Nevada Report Card Star Rating of 4 or 5 AND/OR top 40% for Student CRT Proficiency (Math and ELA MIP=percentage above the cut) for 80% (16/20) of subgroups annually based on current school year
- Category 3: Top 40% for proficiency target in ELA and Math for special population(s) Nevada Report Card Star Rating of 4 or 5 AND be nominated by LEA for excellence in serving special population of students annually based on current school year
- ✓ Not been recognized as a National ESEA Distinguished School during the previous two years; and a Nevada ESEA Distinguished School for the prior year
