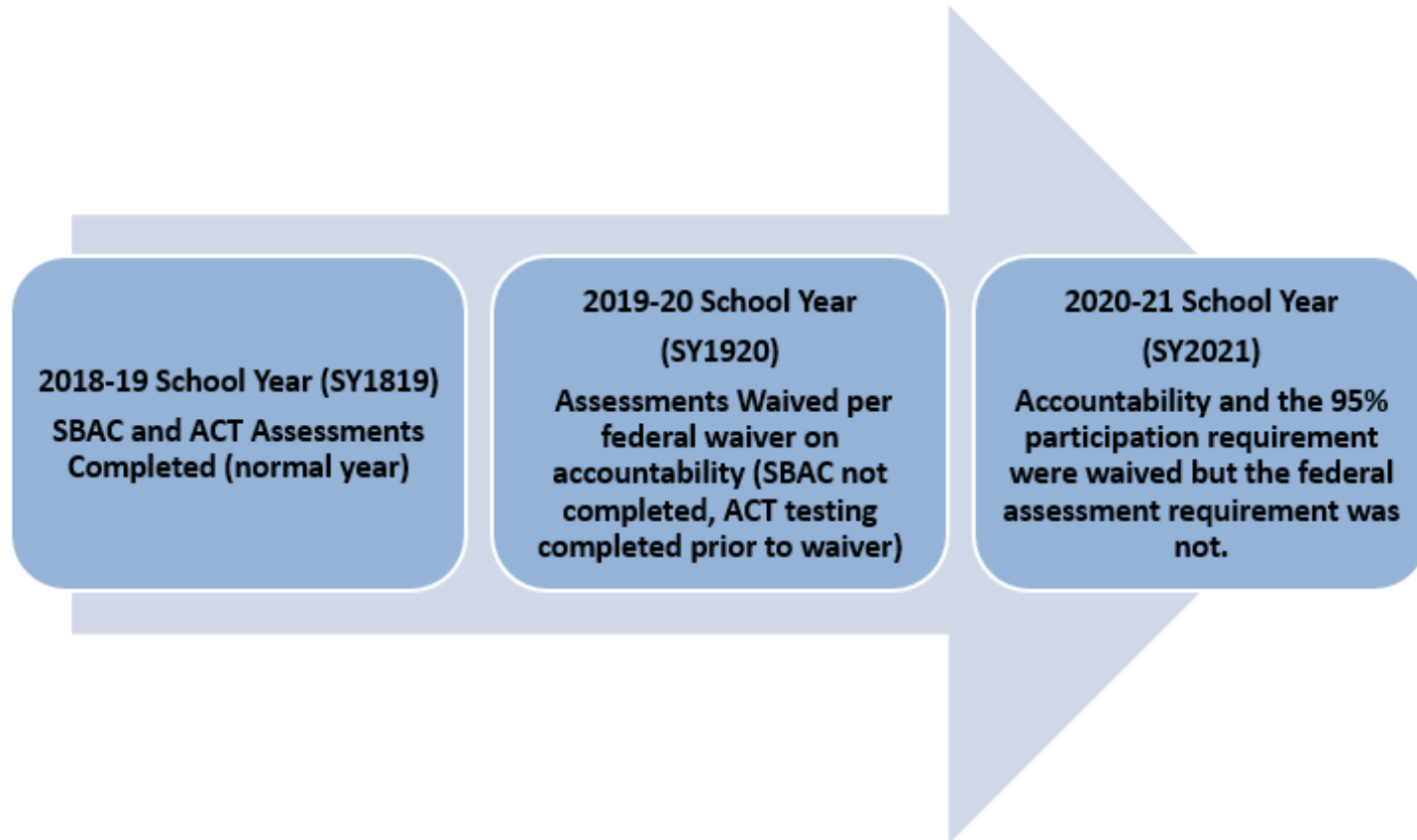
Presentation Outcomes

 - *Meets federal requirement to assess students in grades 3-8 in ELA and mathematics annually*
2. Overview of ACT grade 11 assessment for ELA and mathematics SY2021
 - *Meets federal requirement for a college and career readiness assessment for high school students*

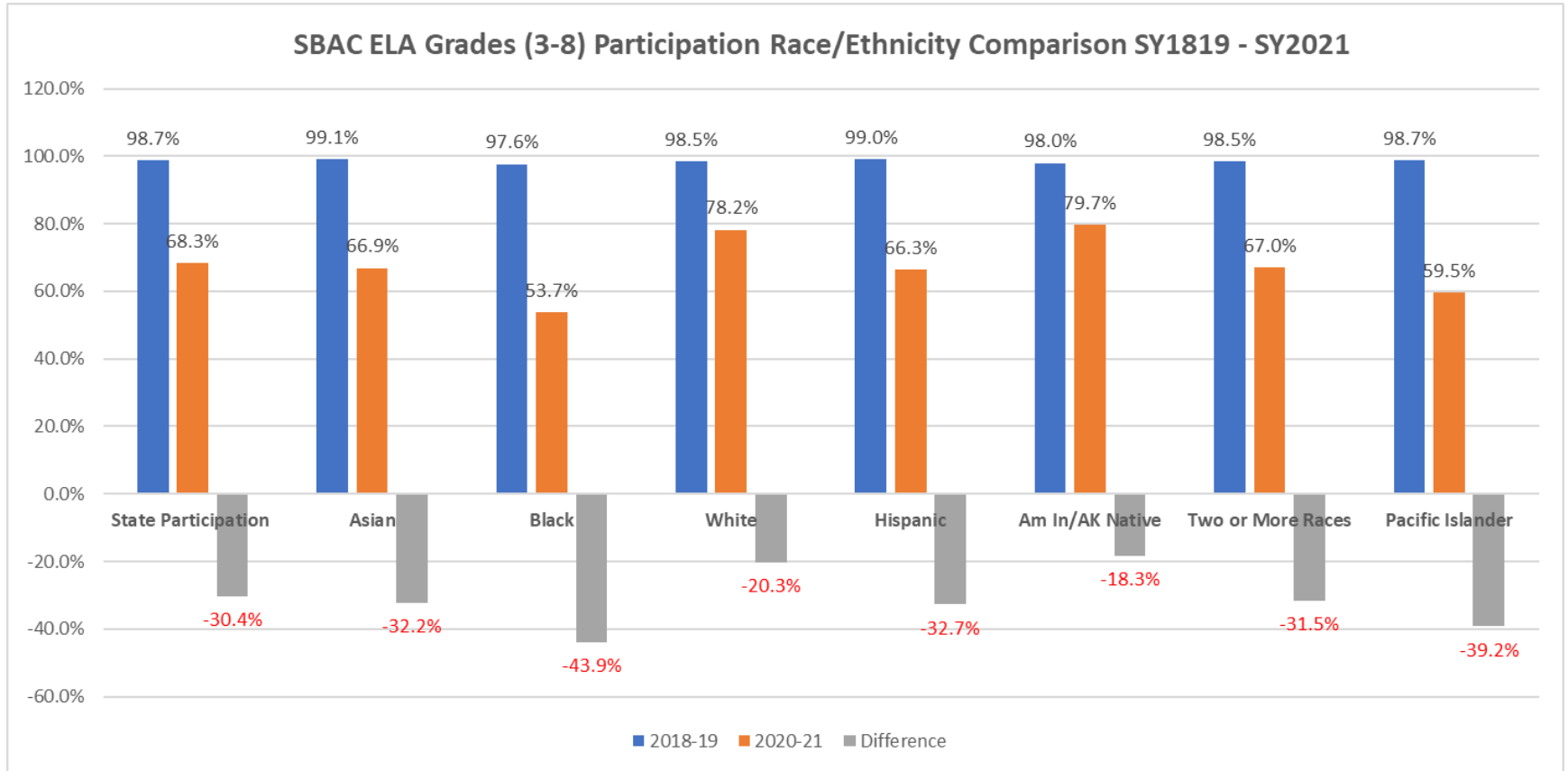

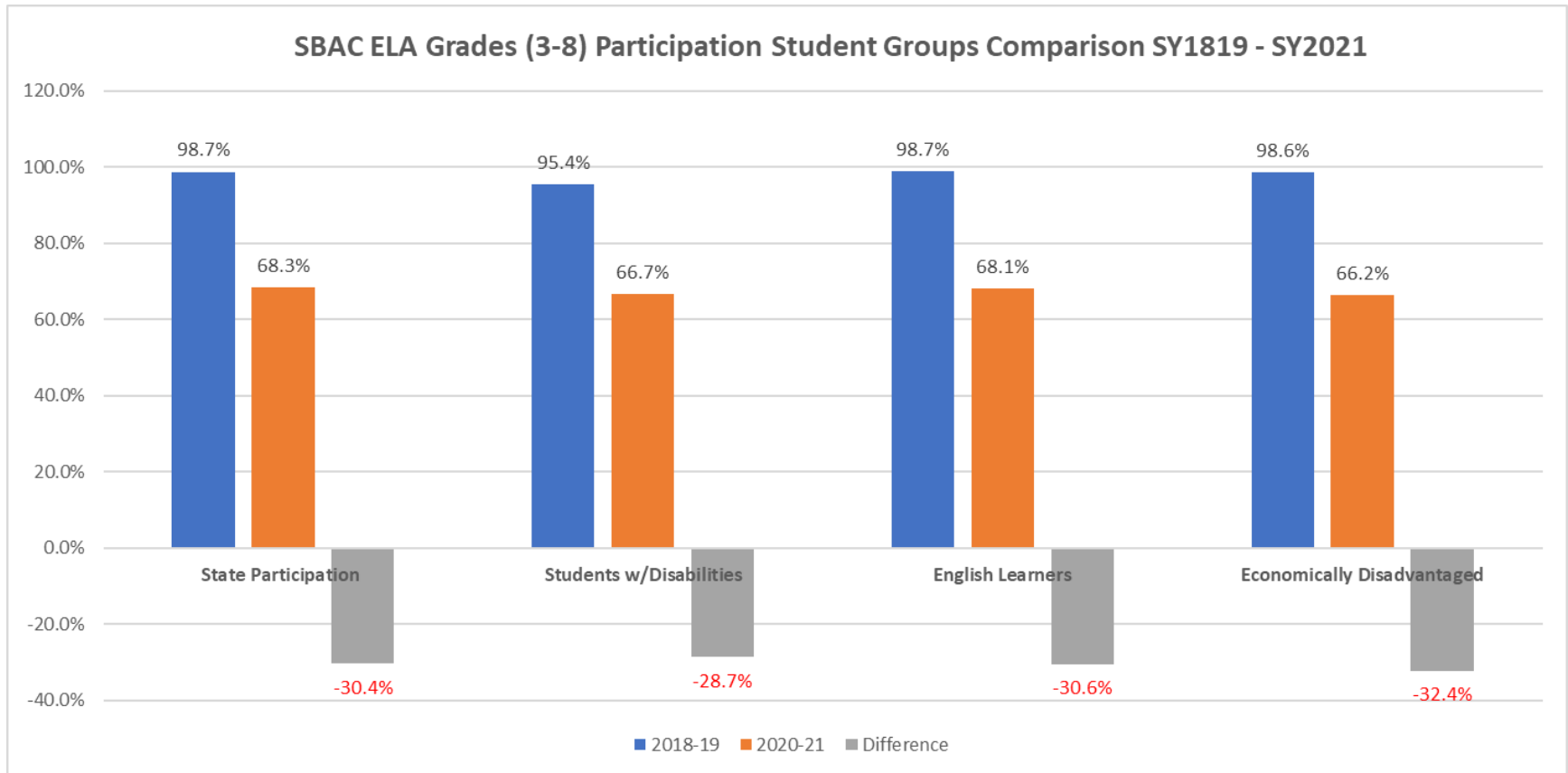
SBAC ELA Participation Rates

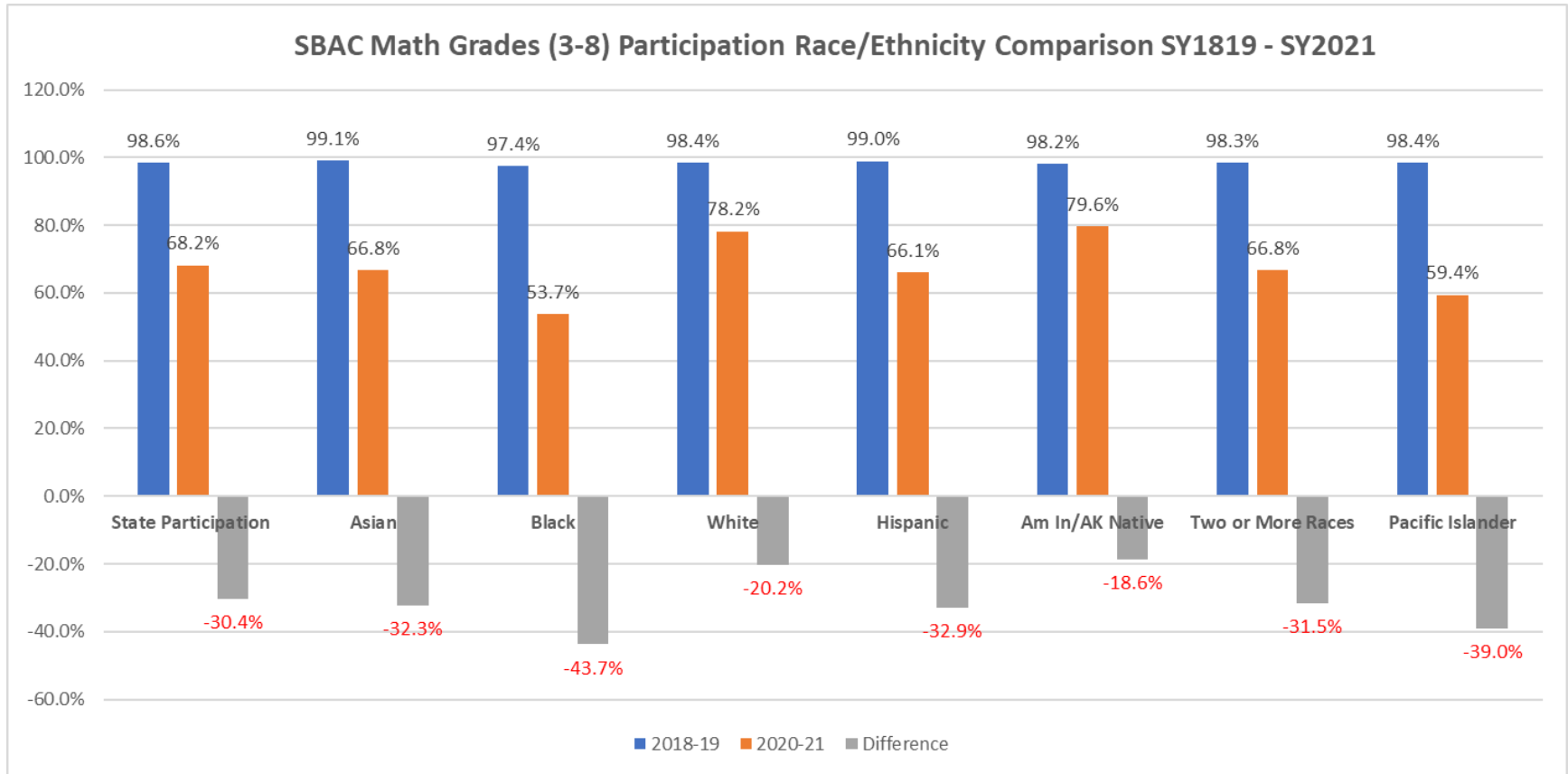


SBAC ELA Participation Rates Comparison

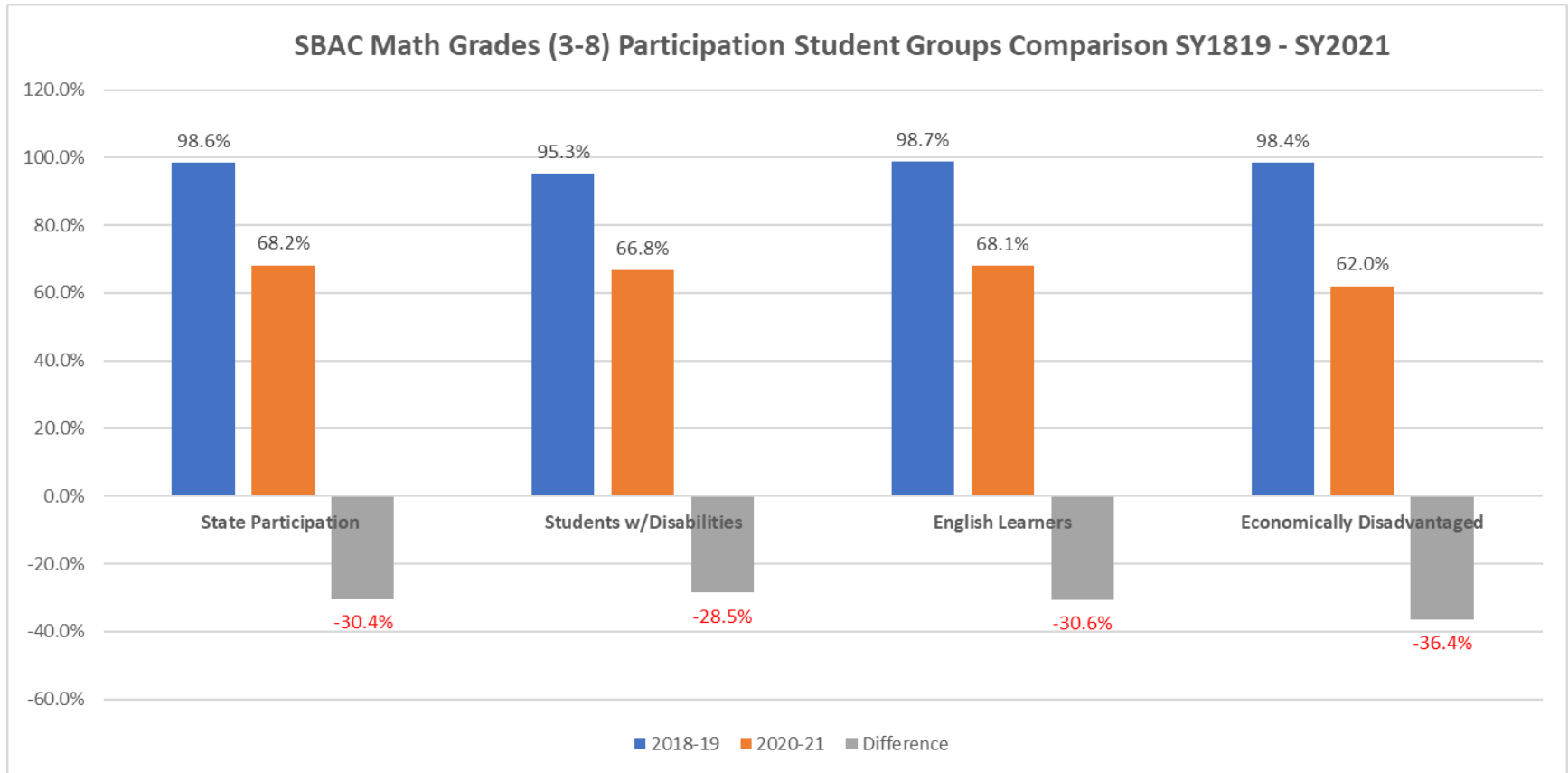
SBAC Math Participation Rates

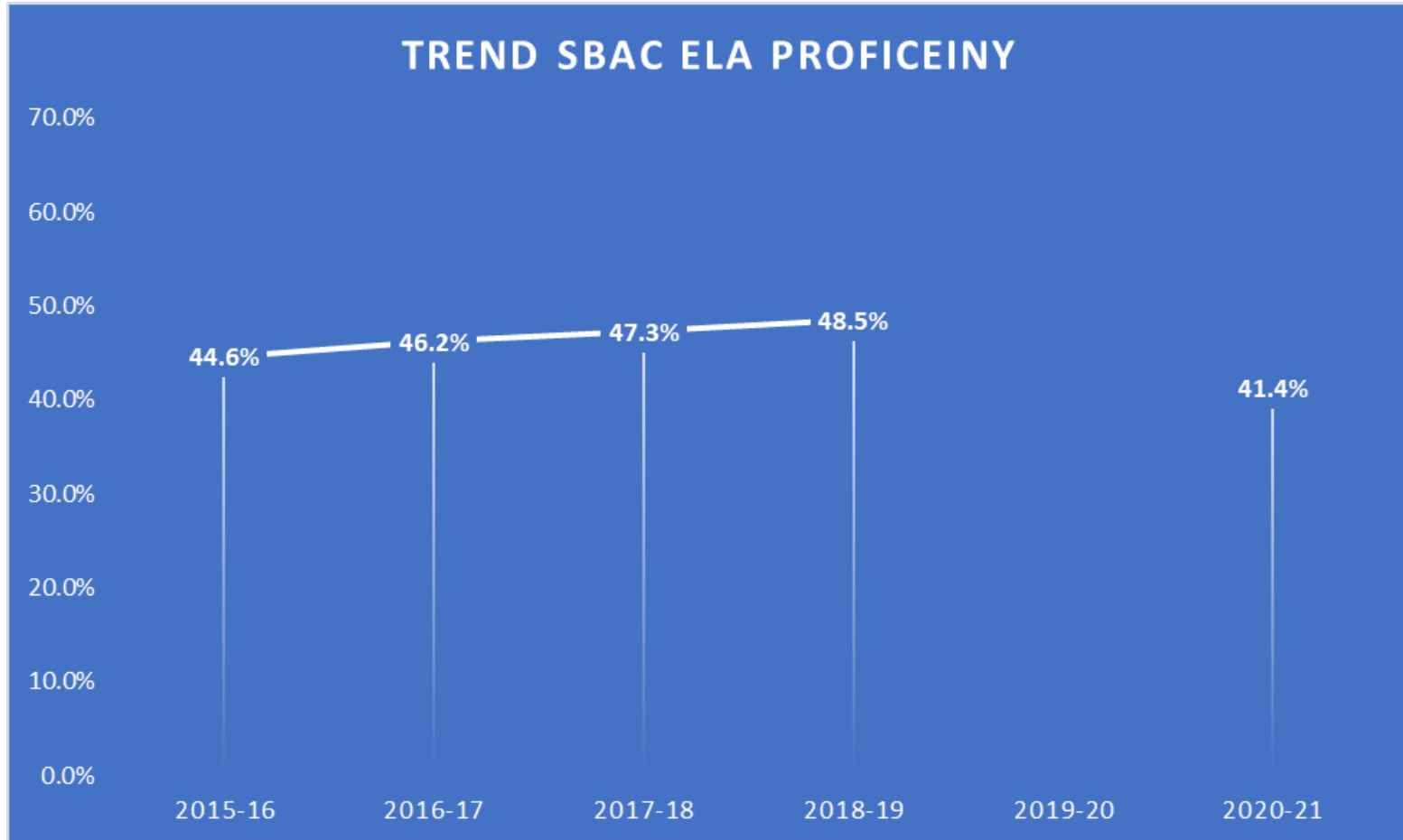


SBAC Math Participation Rates Comparison



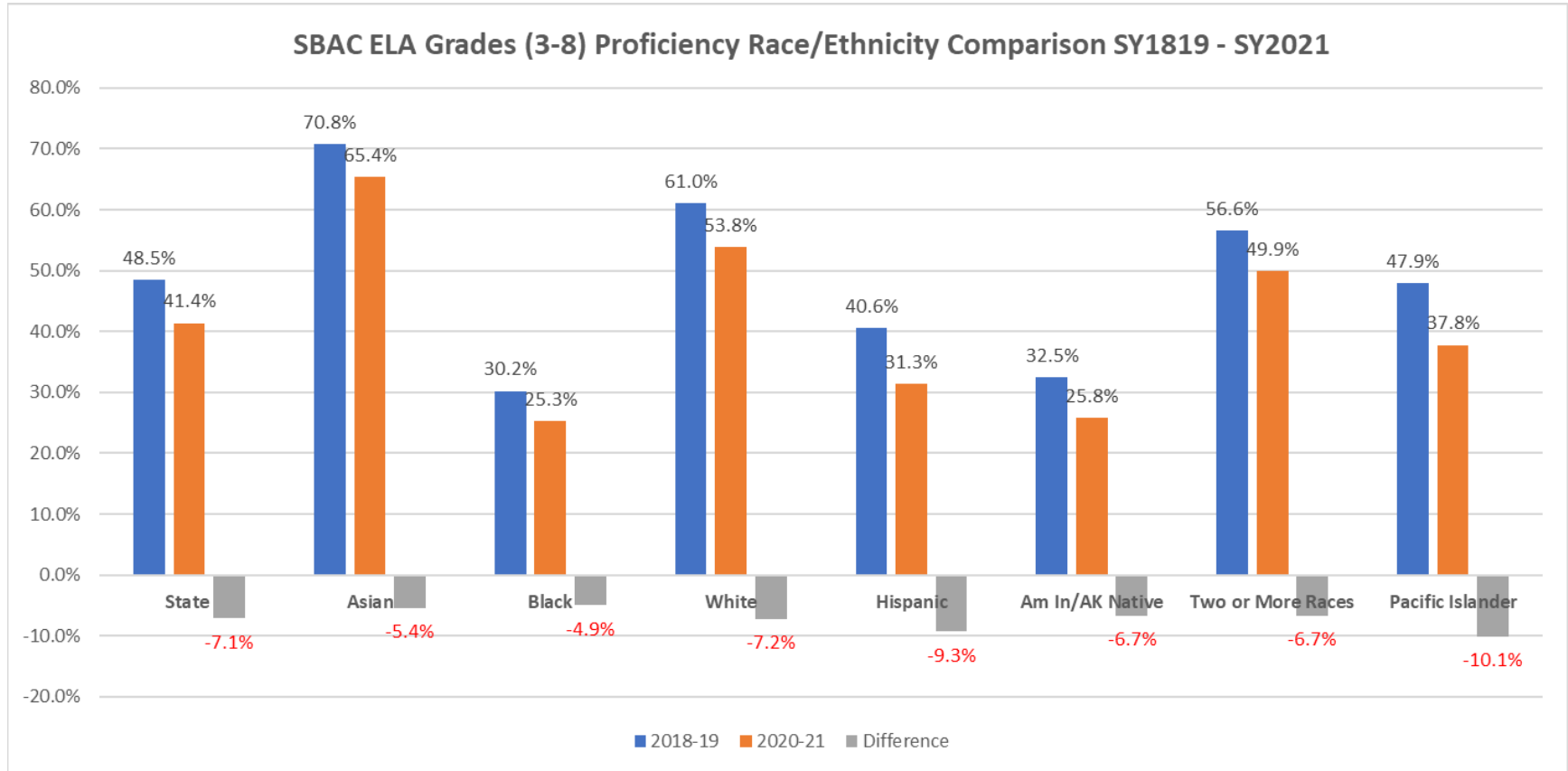

SBAC ELA Proficiency Rate Trend



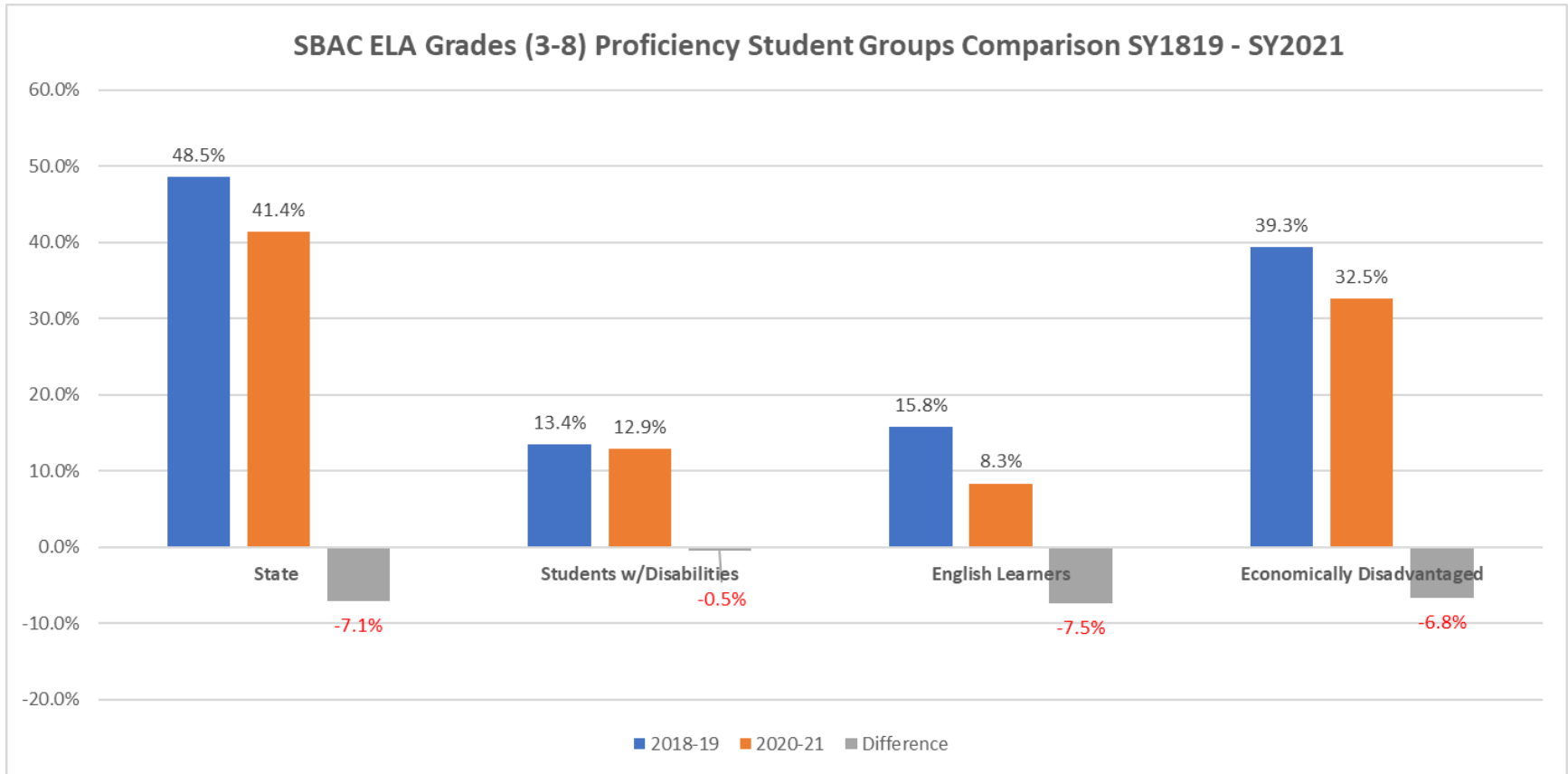

SBAC ELA Race/Ethnicity Proficiency Rates



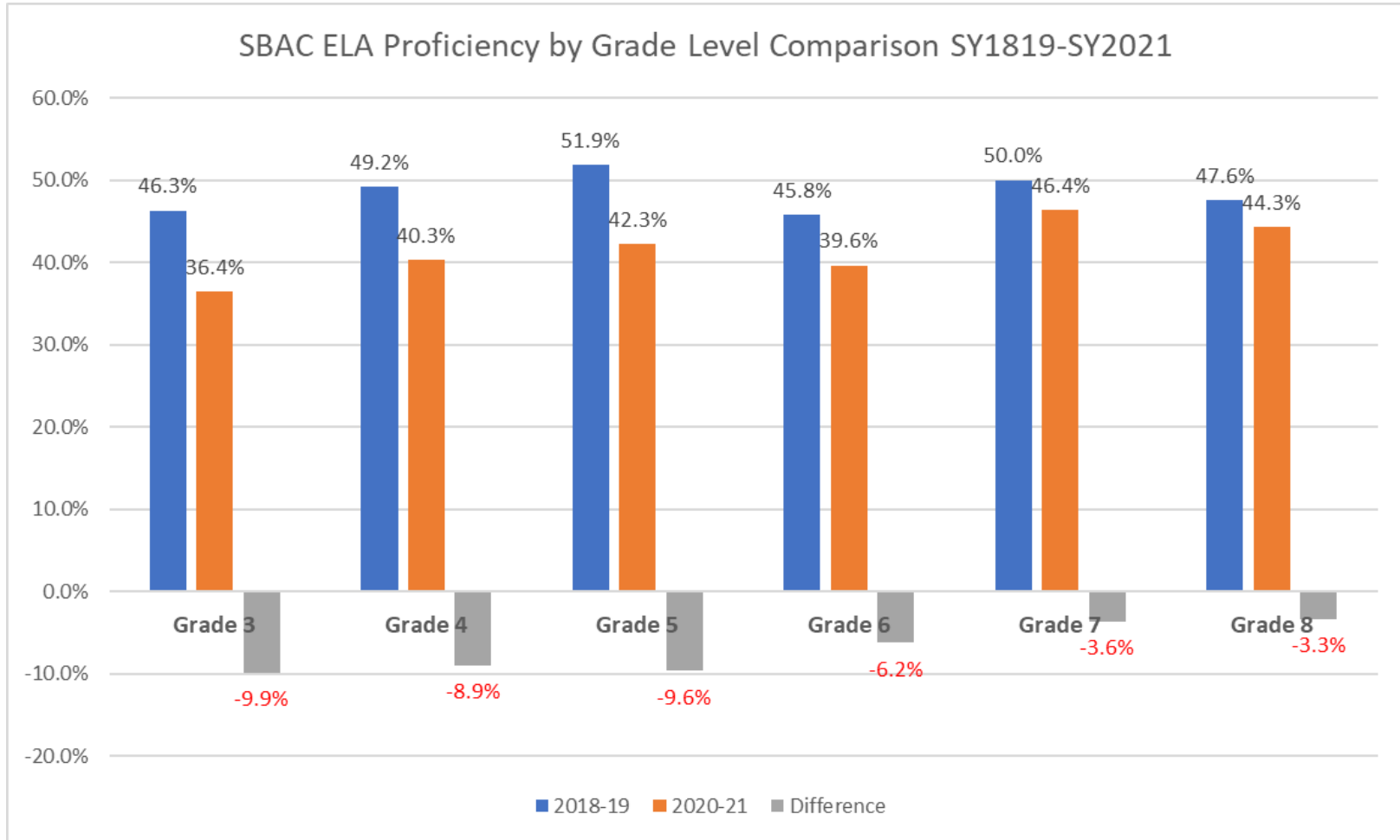

SBAC ELA Student Group Proficiency Rates



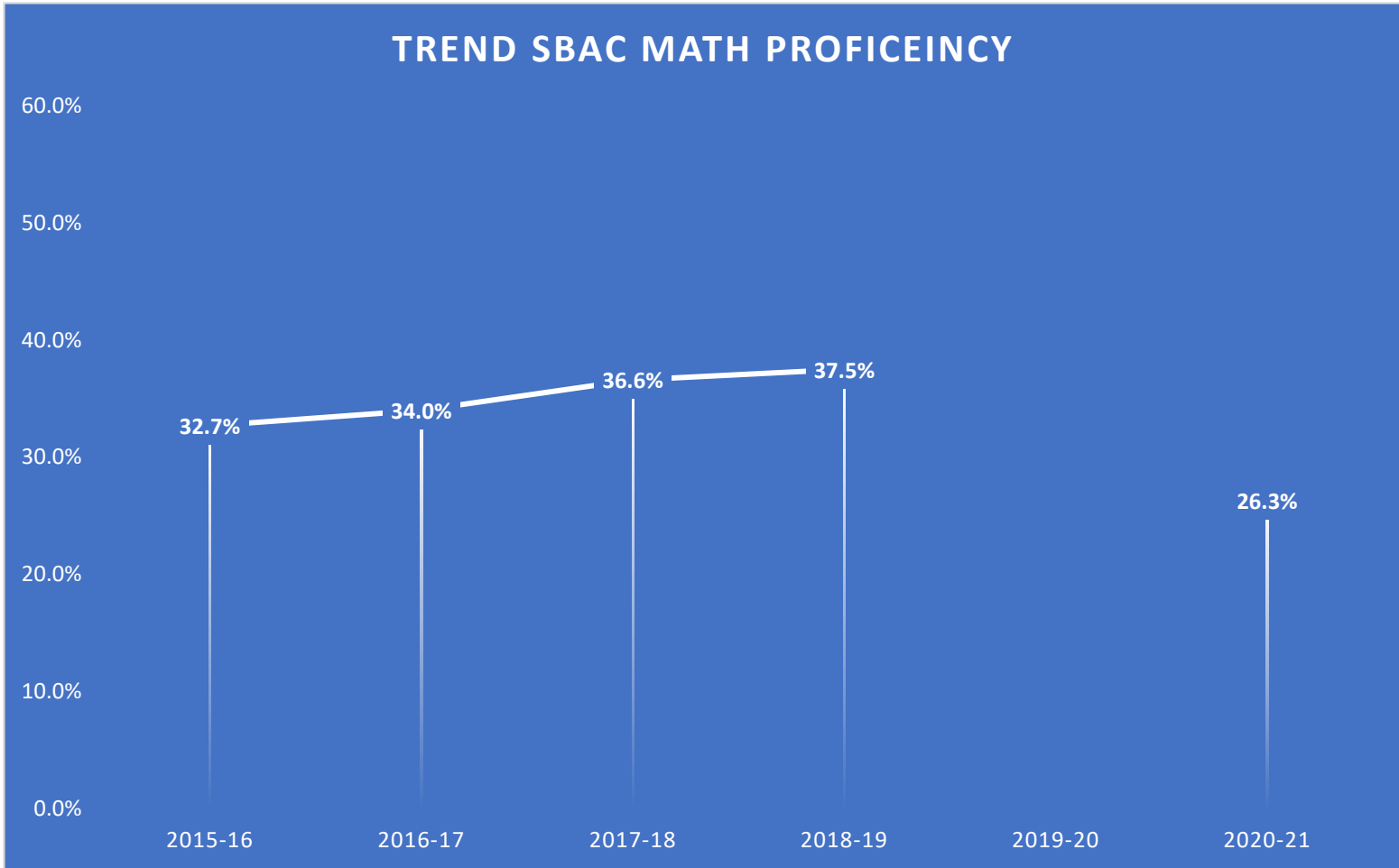

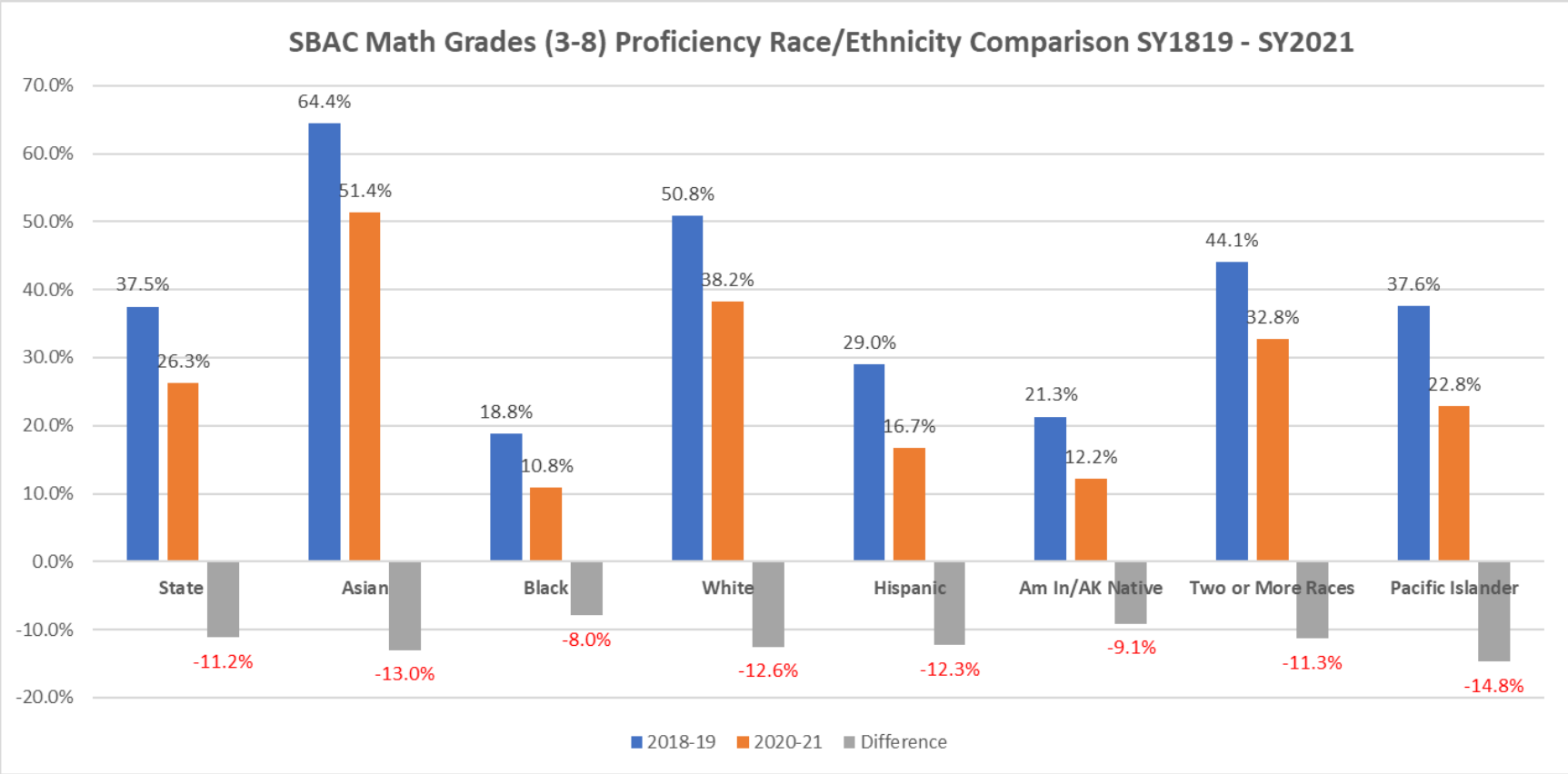

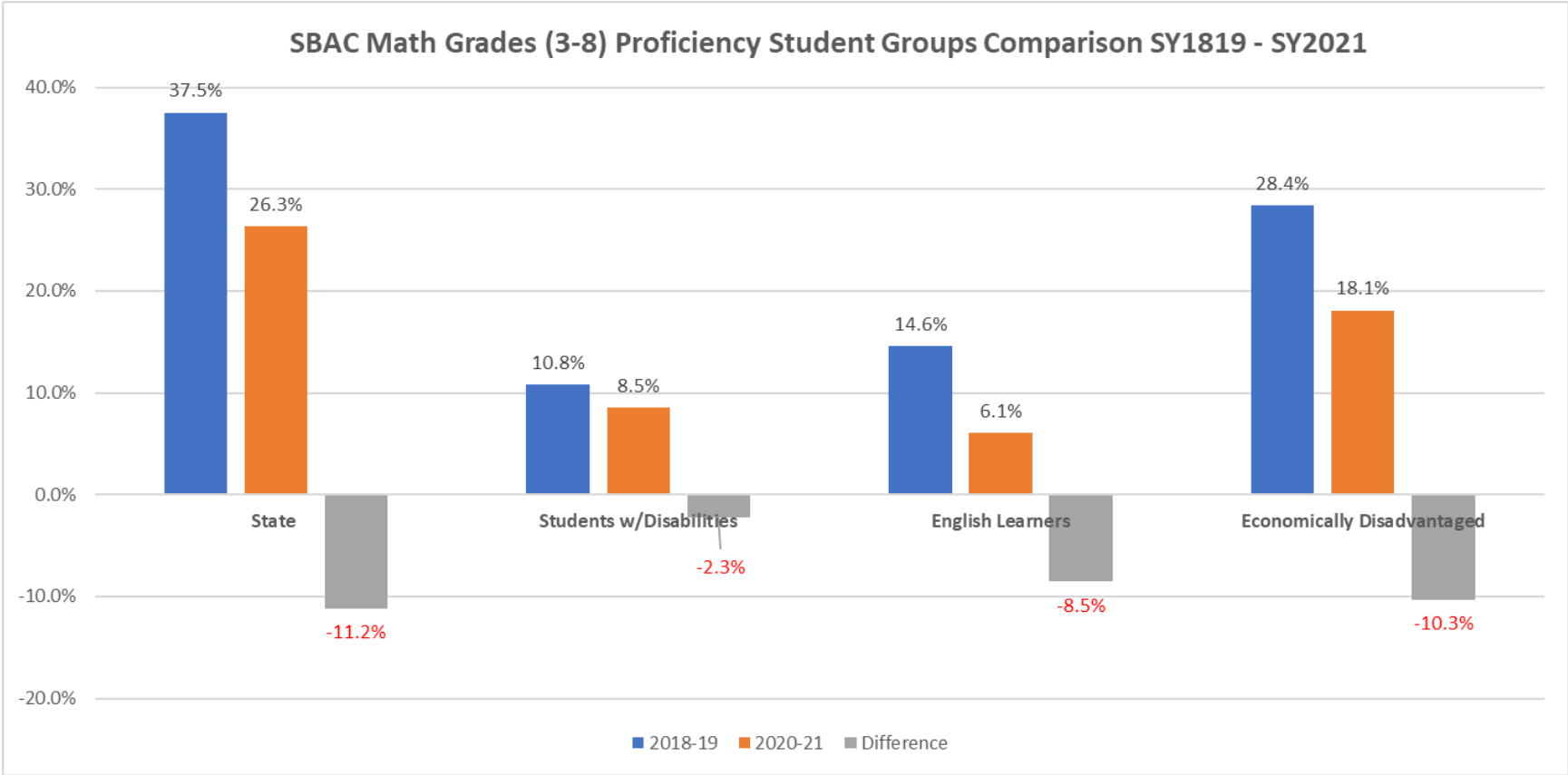
SBAC Race/Ethnicity Math Proficiency Rates

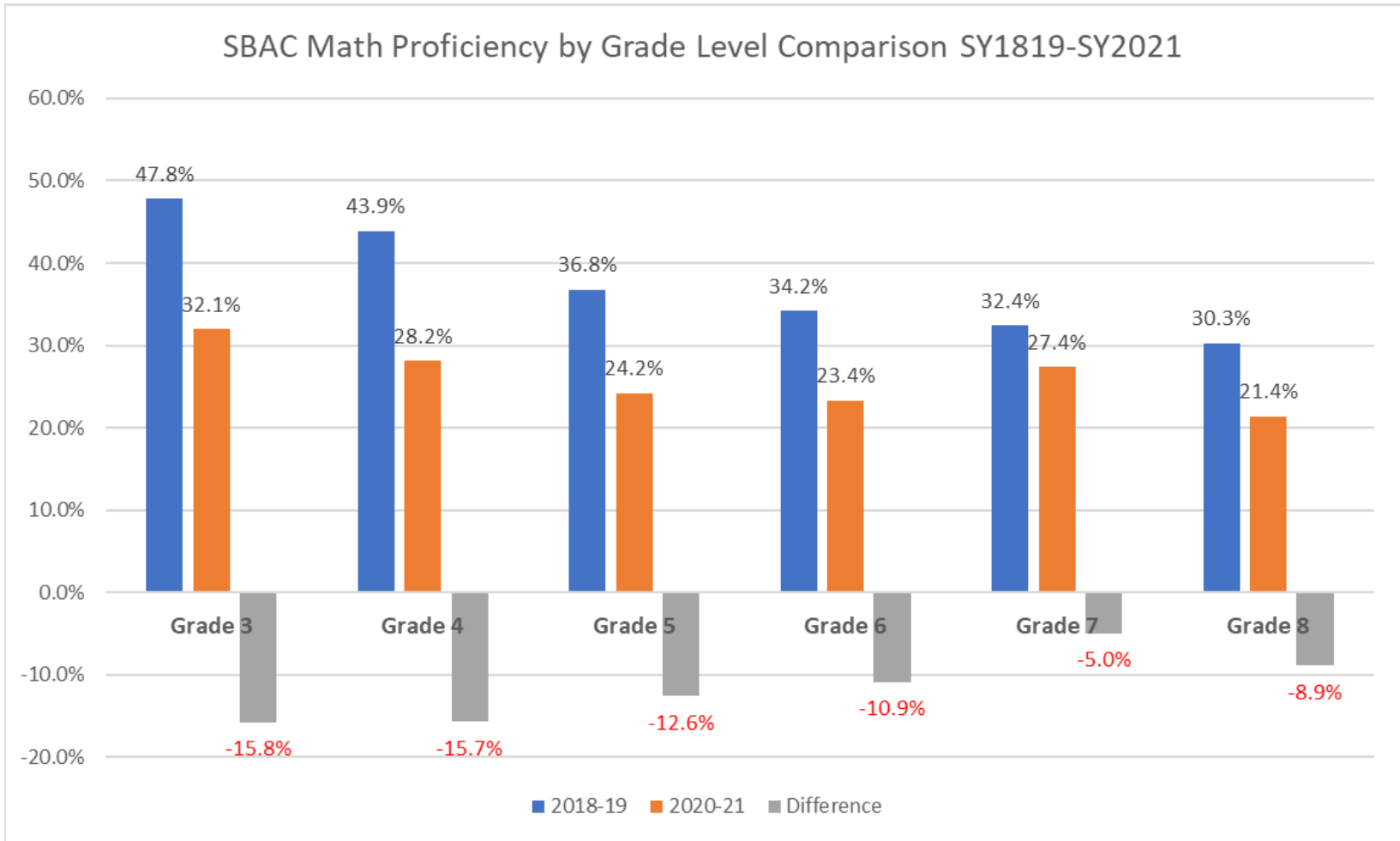
SBAC Student Groups Math Proficiency Rates

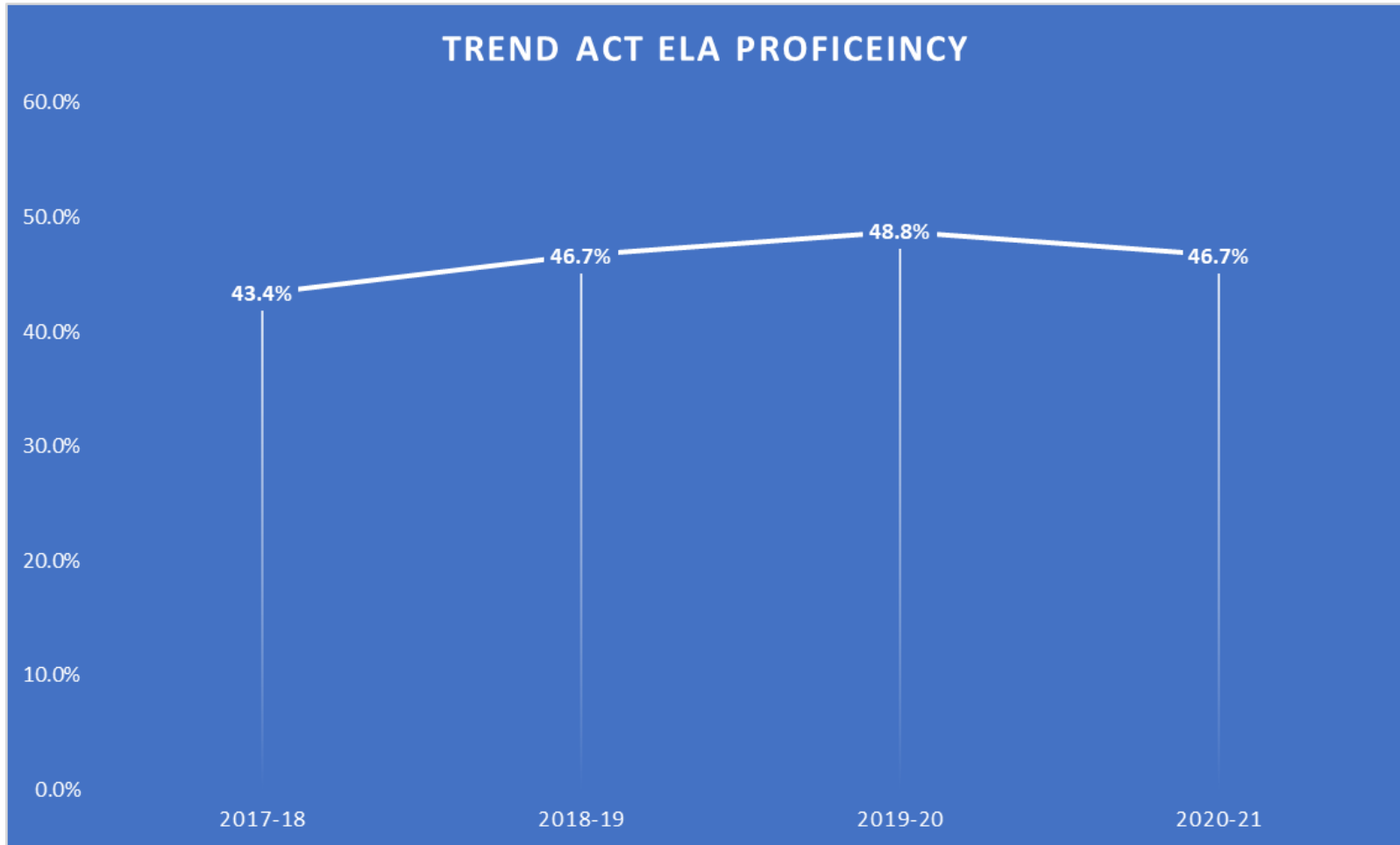

- The ACT was administered to all grade 11 students in SY1920 prior to pandemic-related school building closures, thus results can be compared between SY1920 and SY2021

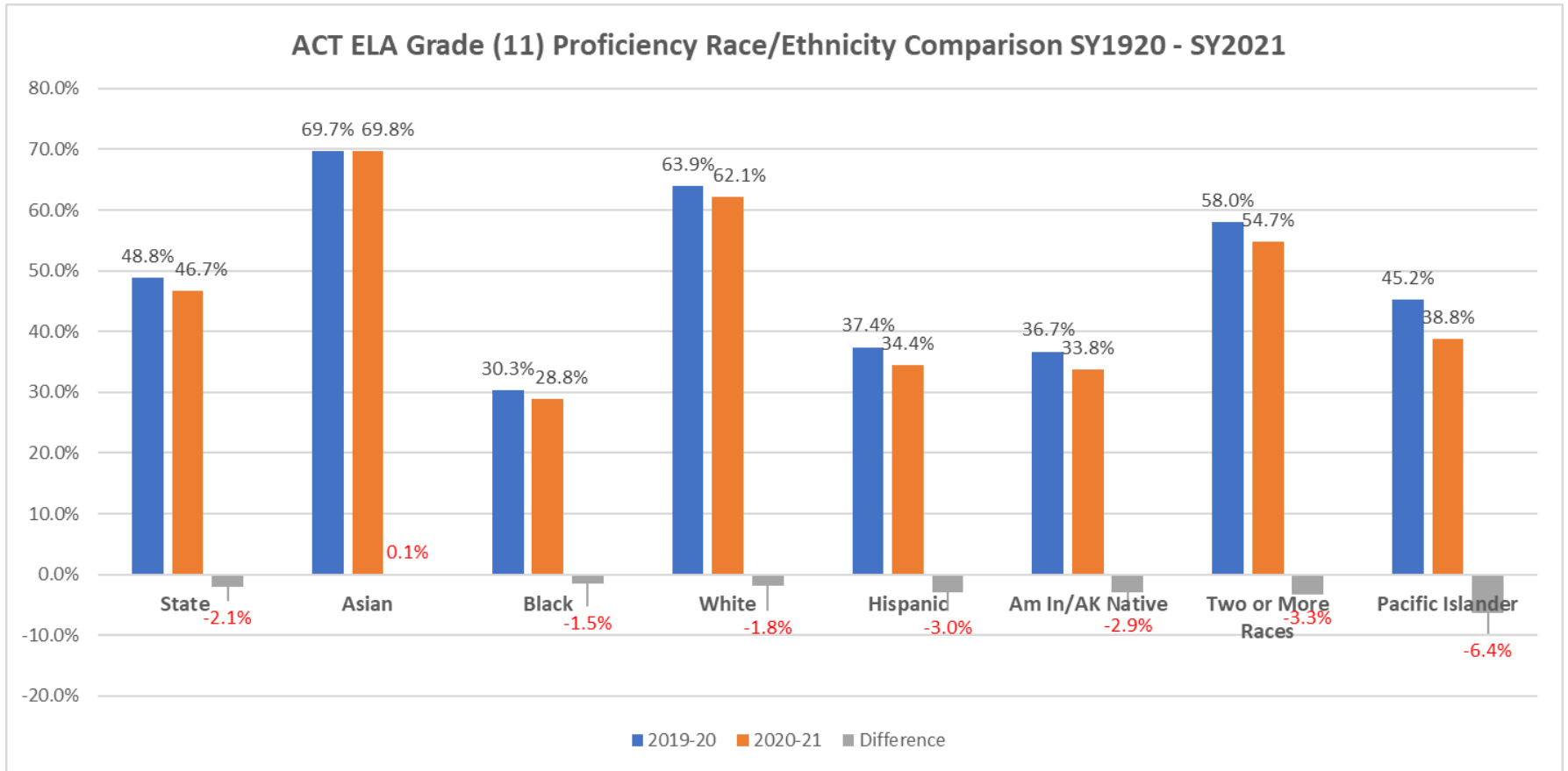
High School ELA Proficiency Rates



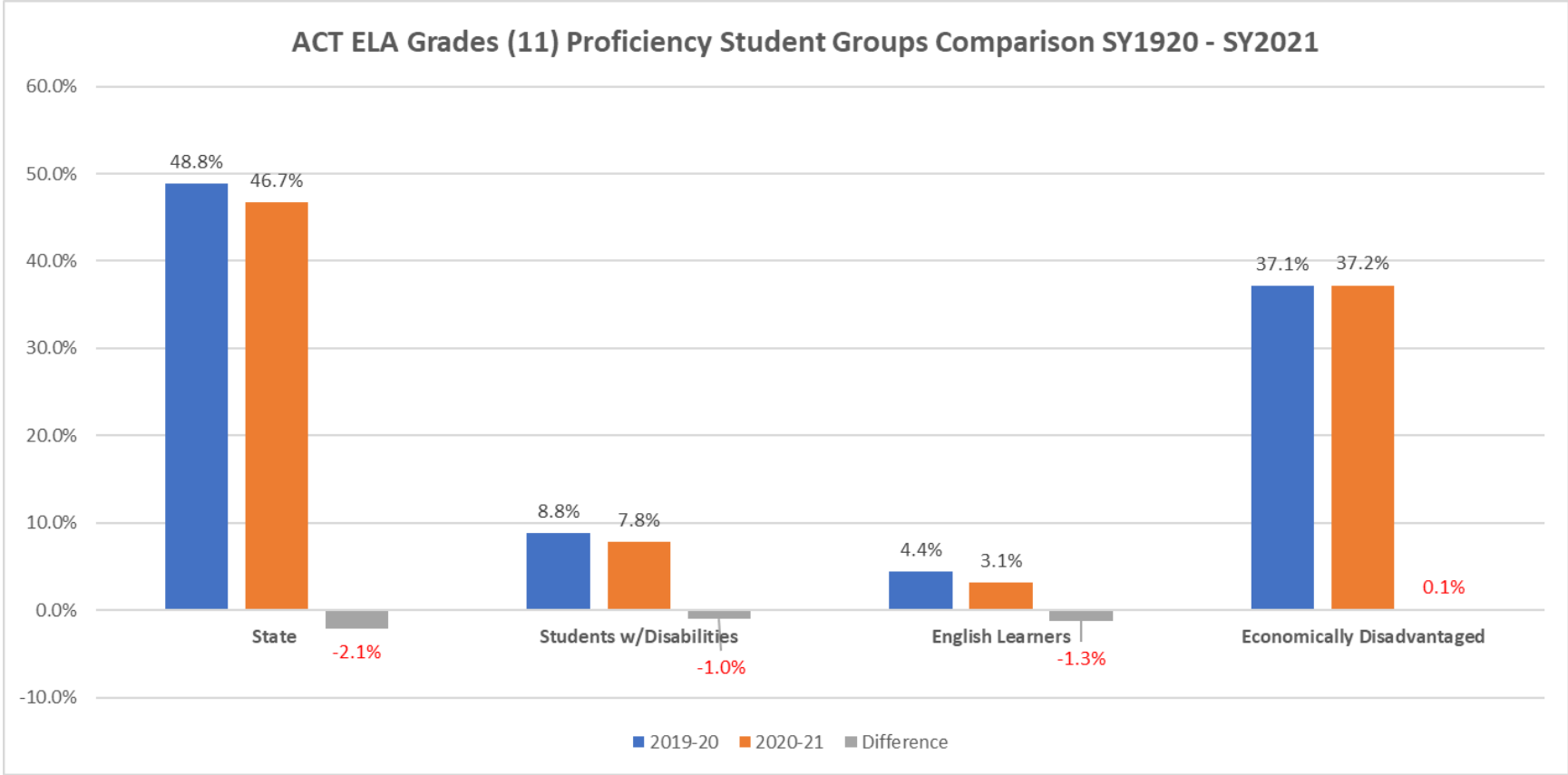
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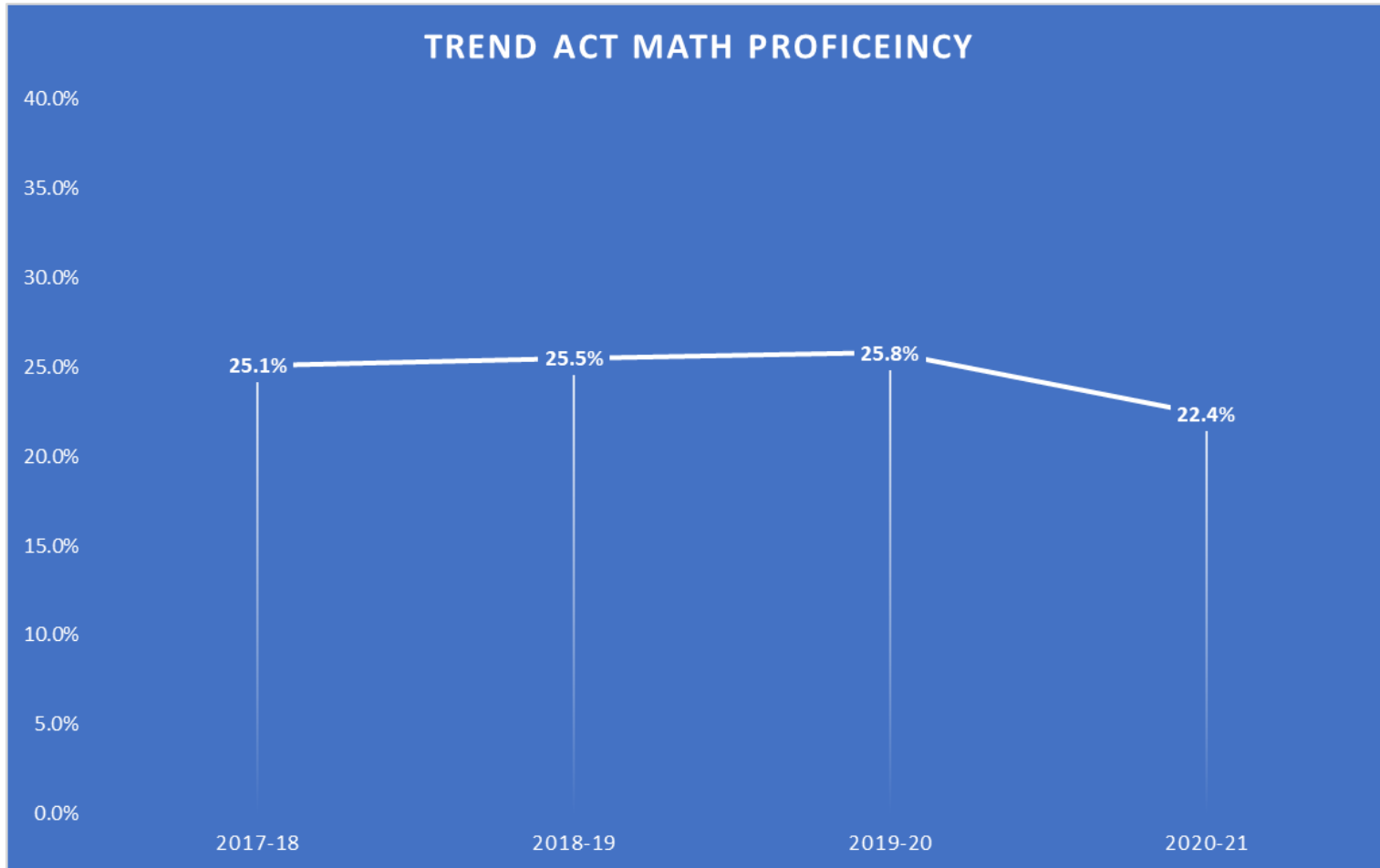
High School ELA Proficiency Rates - Race/Ethnicity



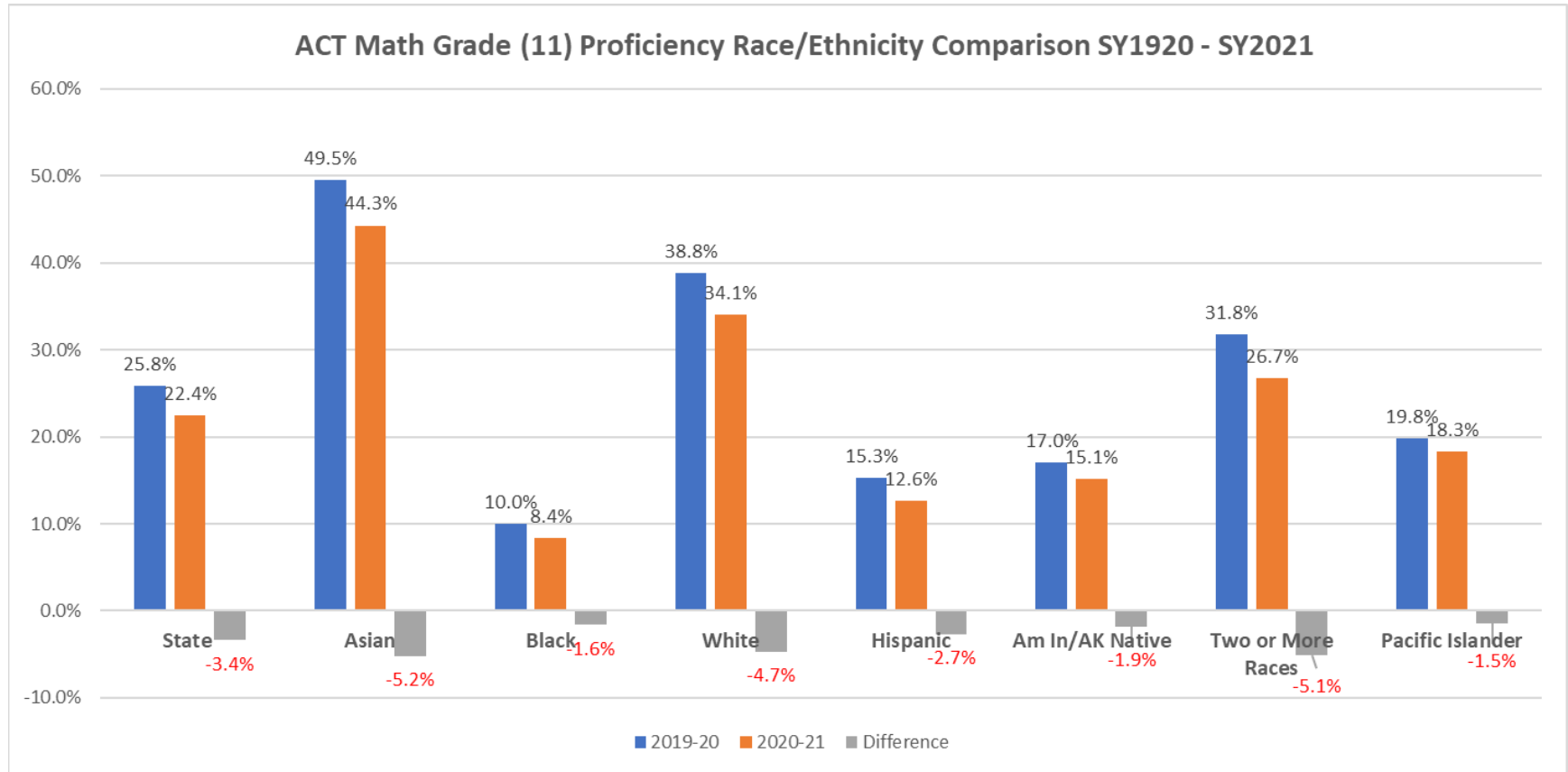
High School ELA Proficiency Rates – Student Groups



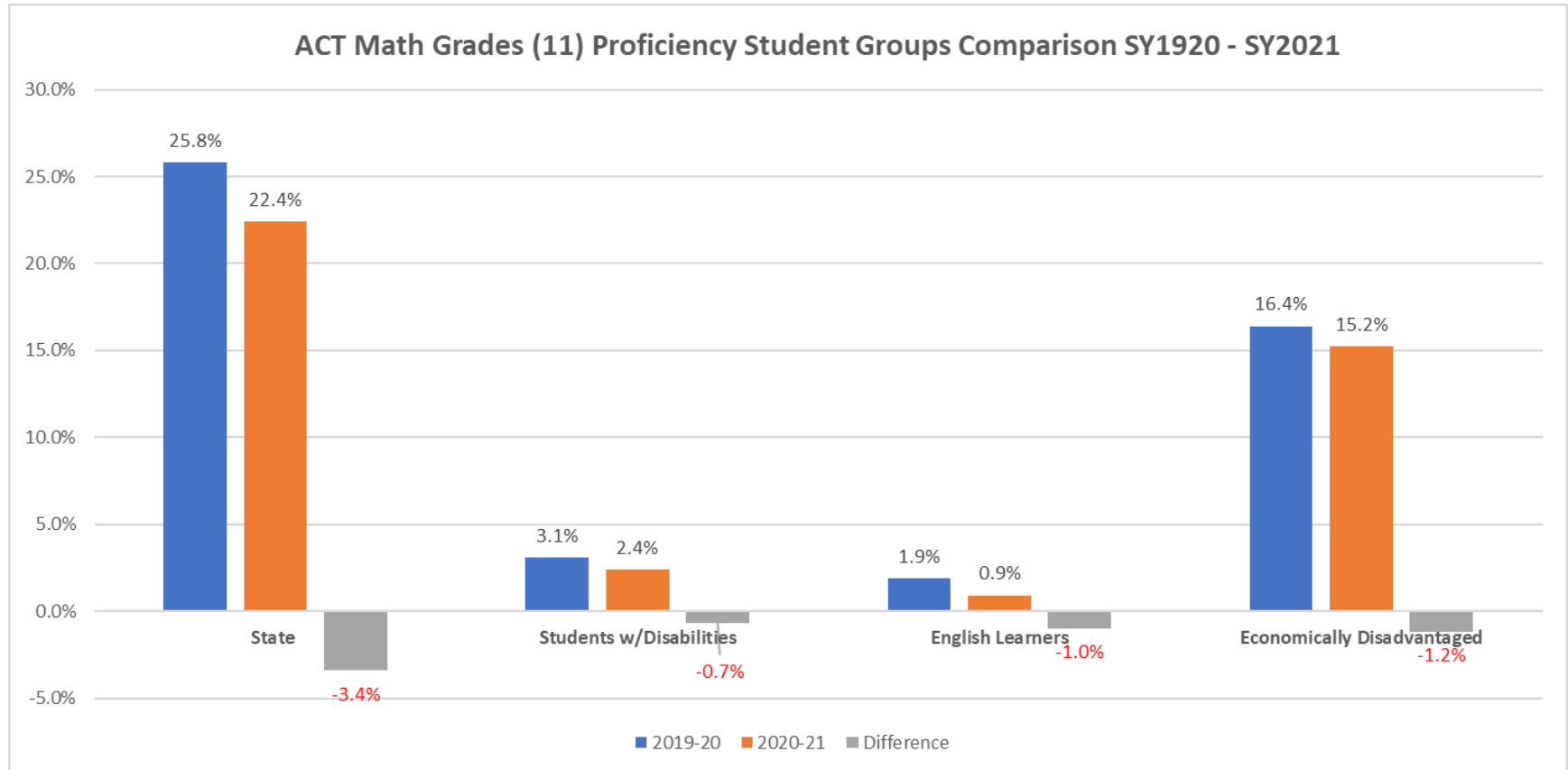
High School Math Proficiency Rates
