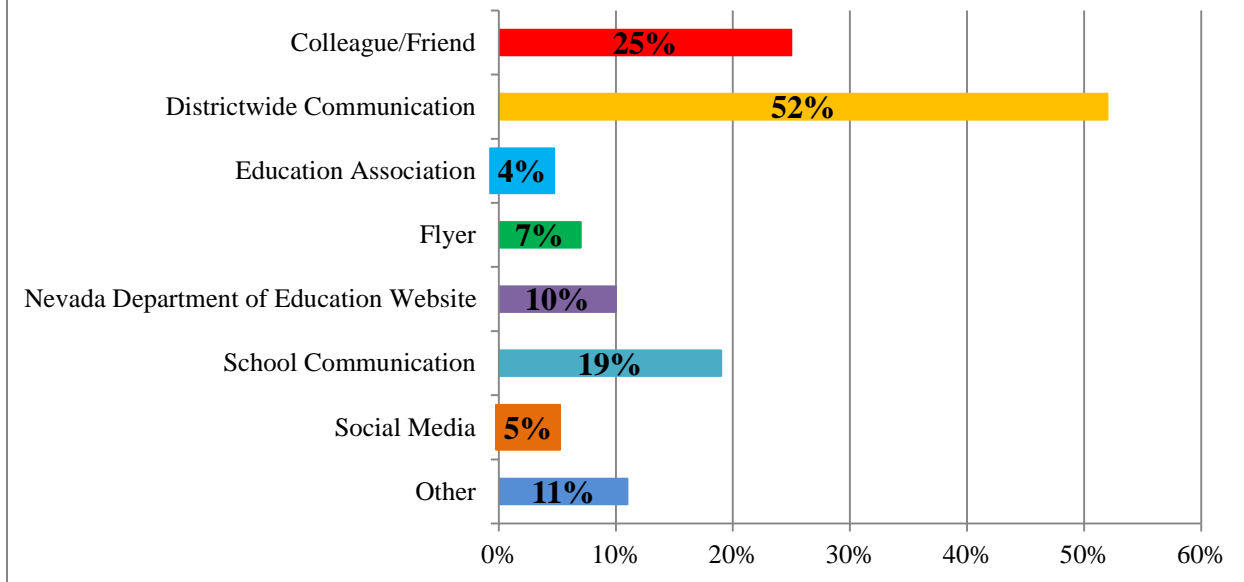

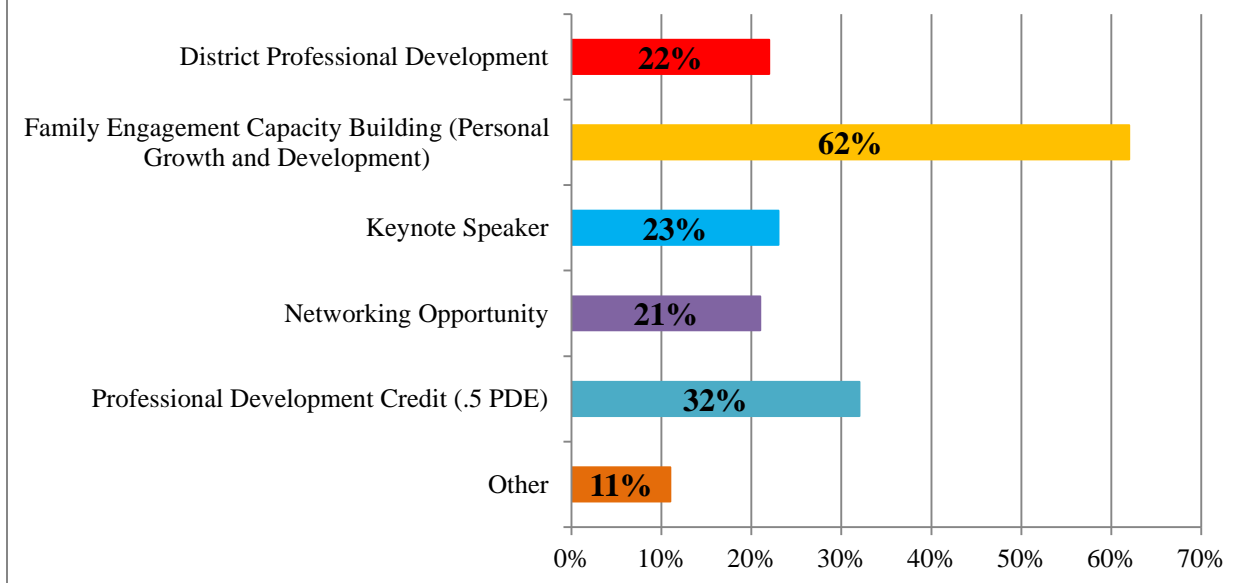

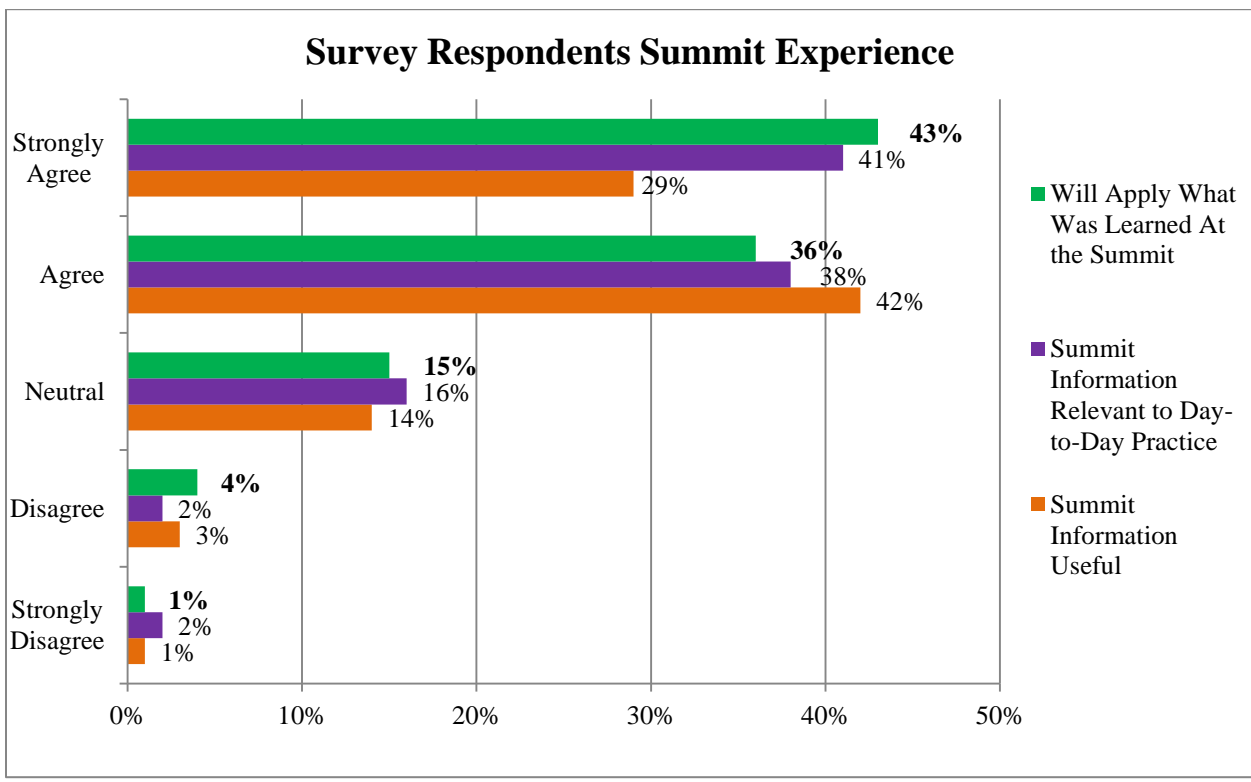

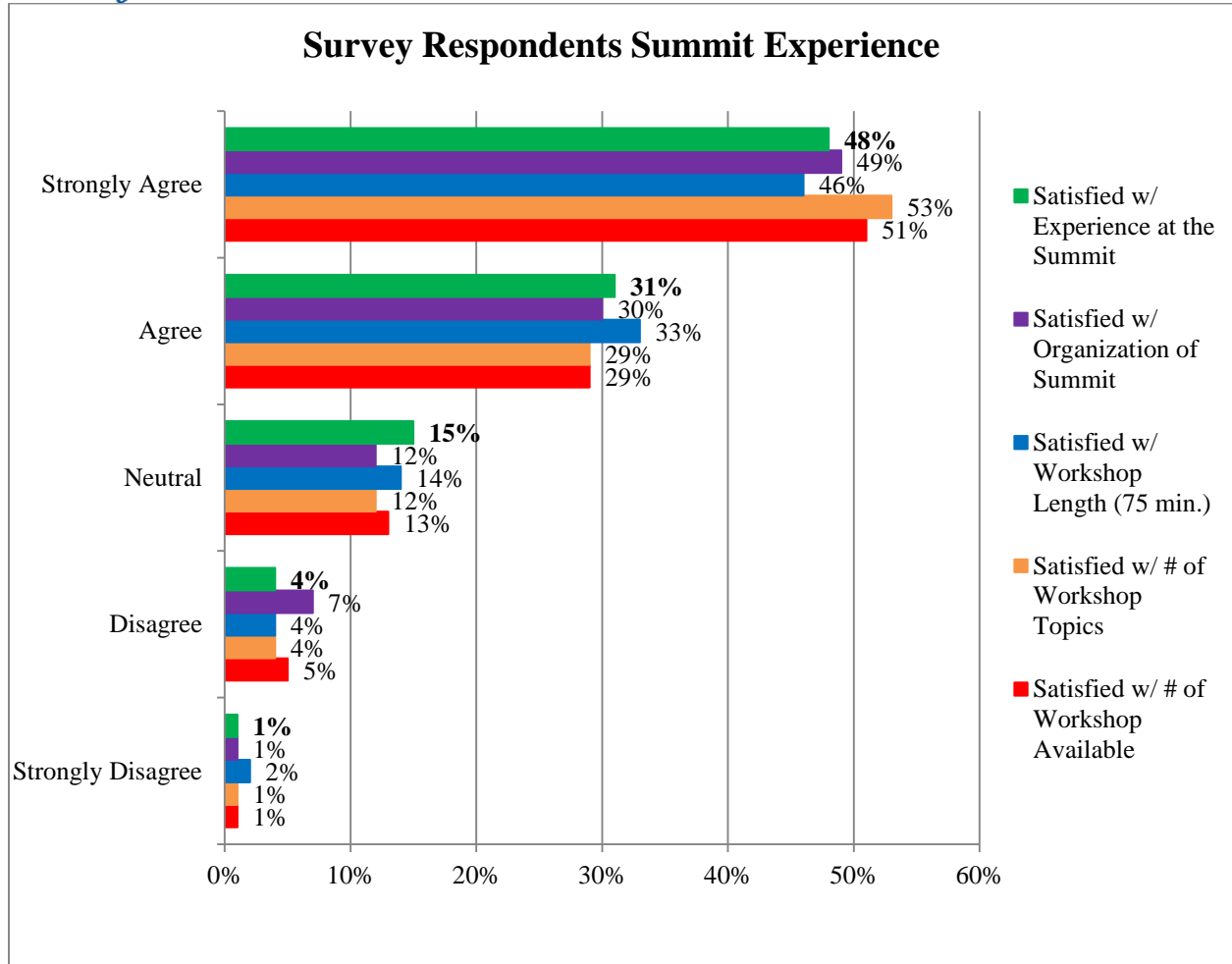
How Survey Respondents Heard About the Summit
