# Auxiliary Services

## Prior Recommendations

- Four-year average of districts actual costs for transportation and food services
- Use a similar “hold harmless” type of adjustment for each of the 4 years of transportation and food service costs manner that is used for the Average Daily Enrollment (ADE) adjustment
- Auxiliary Services use the same Consumer Price Index (CPI) (or Inflation Factor), as the Pupil-Centered Funding Plan (PCFP)
- Charter and university schools be included in the auxiliary services allocation calculations for auxiliary services
- Charter and university schools that currently do not have 4 years of data use the average total based on the number of years that the school has supporting transportation and food services data
- Expansion of transportation or food services to charter schools that have not previously offered auxiliary services, by allowing the applicants to build a line-item budget that would be submitted to the Nevada Department of Education through an application process

# Decision Point

- Should districts be allowed the same opportunity to apply for additional funds through the same process of a charter school applicant applying to receive auxiliary services funding for the first time?
