






MAP Growth Sample Item

Growth over time





Proportion at/below 40th percentile – Kindergarten








Proportion at/below 40th percentile – First Grade





Proportion at/below 40th percentile – Second Grade






Growth by Race/Ethnicity – Kindergarten through Second Grade
