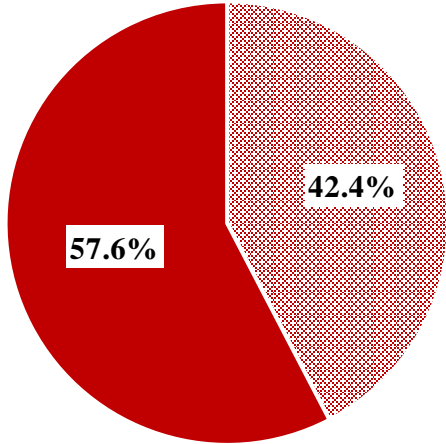

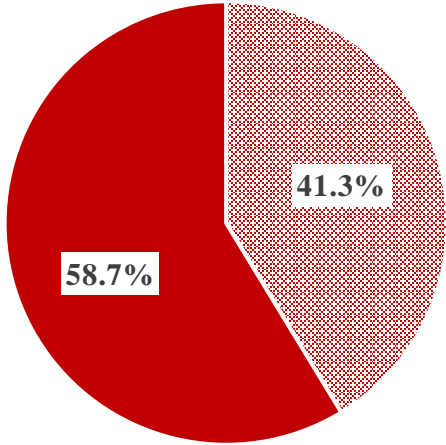

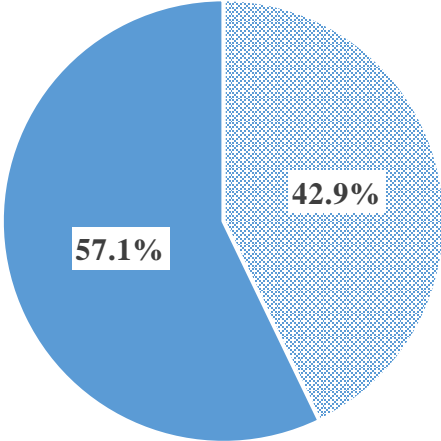

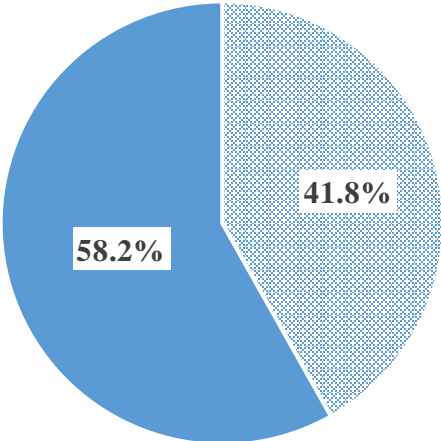

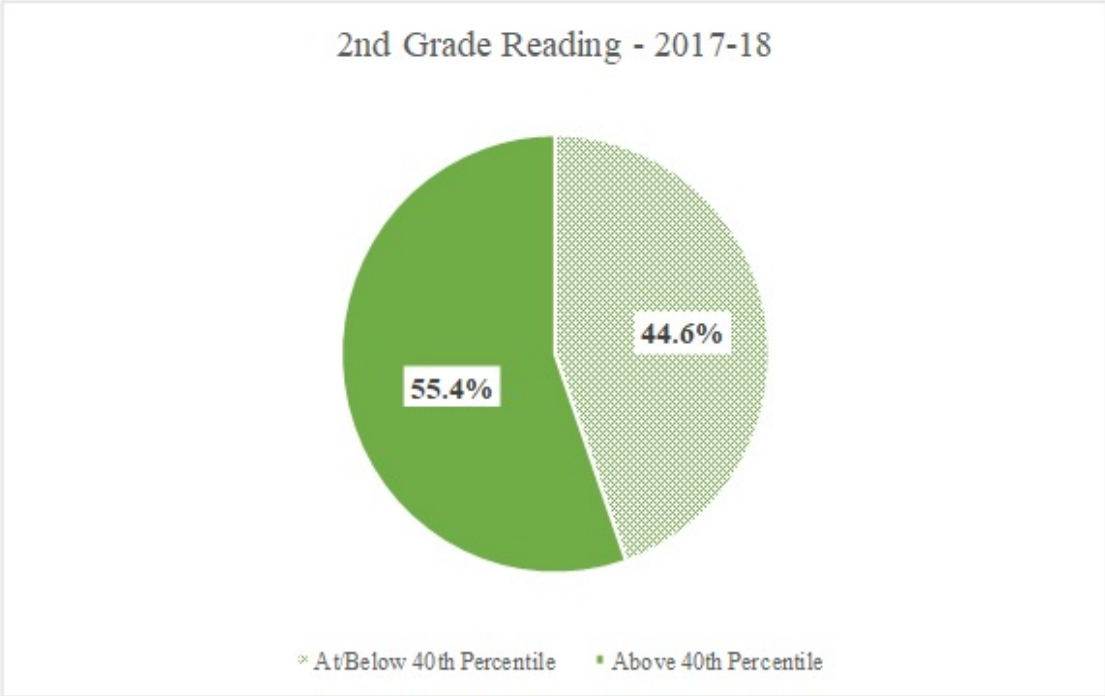

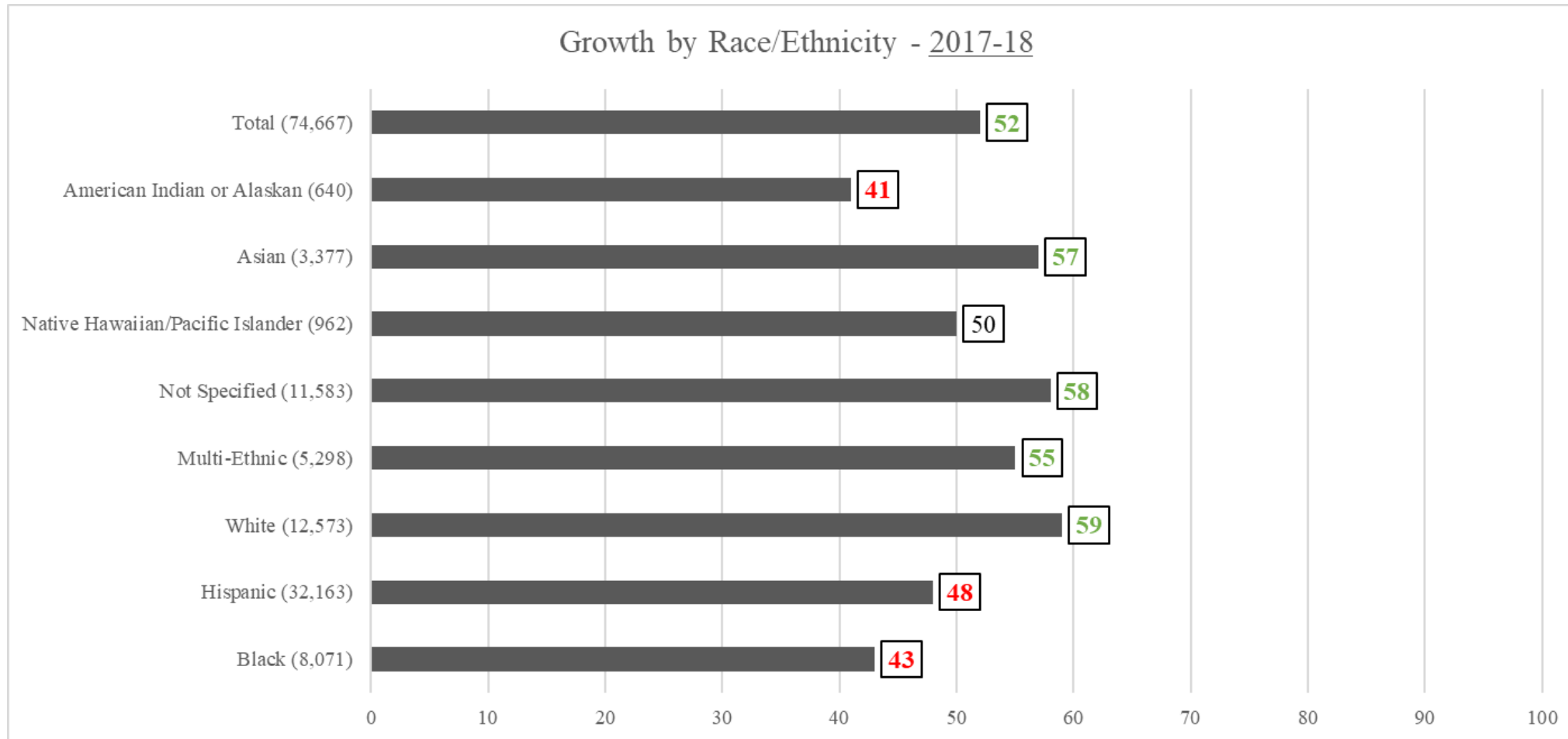

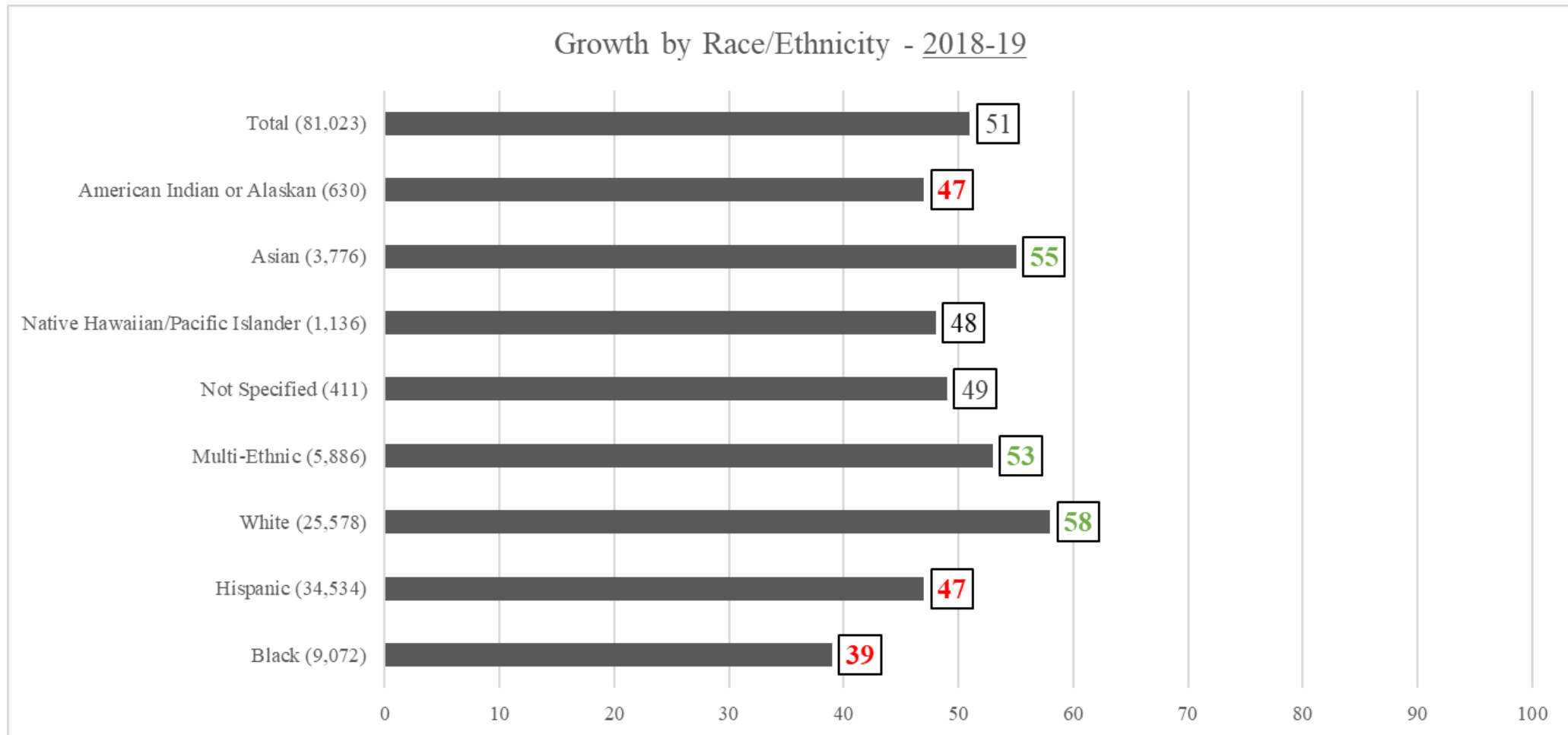
Growth by Race/Ethnicity – Kindergarten through Second Grade
