Great Teaching and Leading Fund (GTLF): NRS 391A.505

State Board of Education Authority

Based upon the recommendations made by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the State Board shall award grants of money to each applicant with an approved application not later than December 31 of each year.

Eligible Entities

- Governing body of a regional training program for the professional development of teachers and administrators
- Board of trustees of a school district
- Governing body of a charter school
- State Public Charter School Authority
- University, state college, or community college within the Nevada System of Higher Education
- Employee associations representing licensed educational personnel
- Nonprofit educational organizations

Highlights and Successes

- External Evaluation by ACS Venture recommended continued and increased funding
- Statewide increase in Nationally Board Certified Teachers through Cohort Programs
- Student performance increase of 9.4% in Reading and 4.4% in Writing in White Pine County
- 100% teacher retention - Elko County School District
- 100% of STEM Coaches and administrators reported that science instruction observed in K-5 classrooms was aligned with the NVACS- Carson City School District
- 95.3% of TFA teachers began second year of teaching, 86.3% completed 2 years in high-need, Title I schools in Clark County

2019-2021 Priorities

As approved by the State Board on January 17, 2019 the priorities for **2019-2020 (FY20) and 2020-2021 (FY21)** GTLF must address one or more of the following:

- Teacher Preparation, Recruitment, Retention, and Leadership
 - » Including building the teacher pipeline
- Nevada Academic Content Standards
 - Newly adopted and/or revised after June 2017 to include, but not limited to:
 - » Computer Science
 - » Social Studies
 - » Fine Arts
 - » Financial Literacy
- School Leadership
 - NEPF with a focus on Student Learning Goals
 - Effective models of school improvement

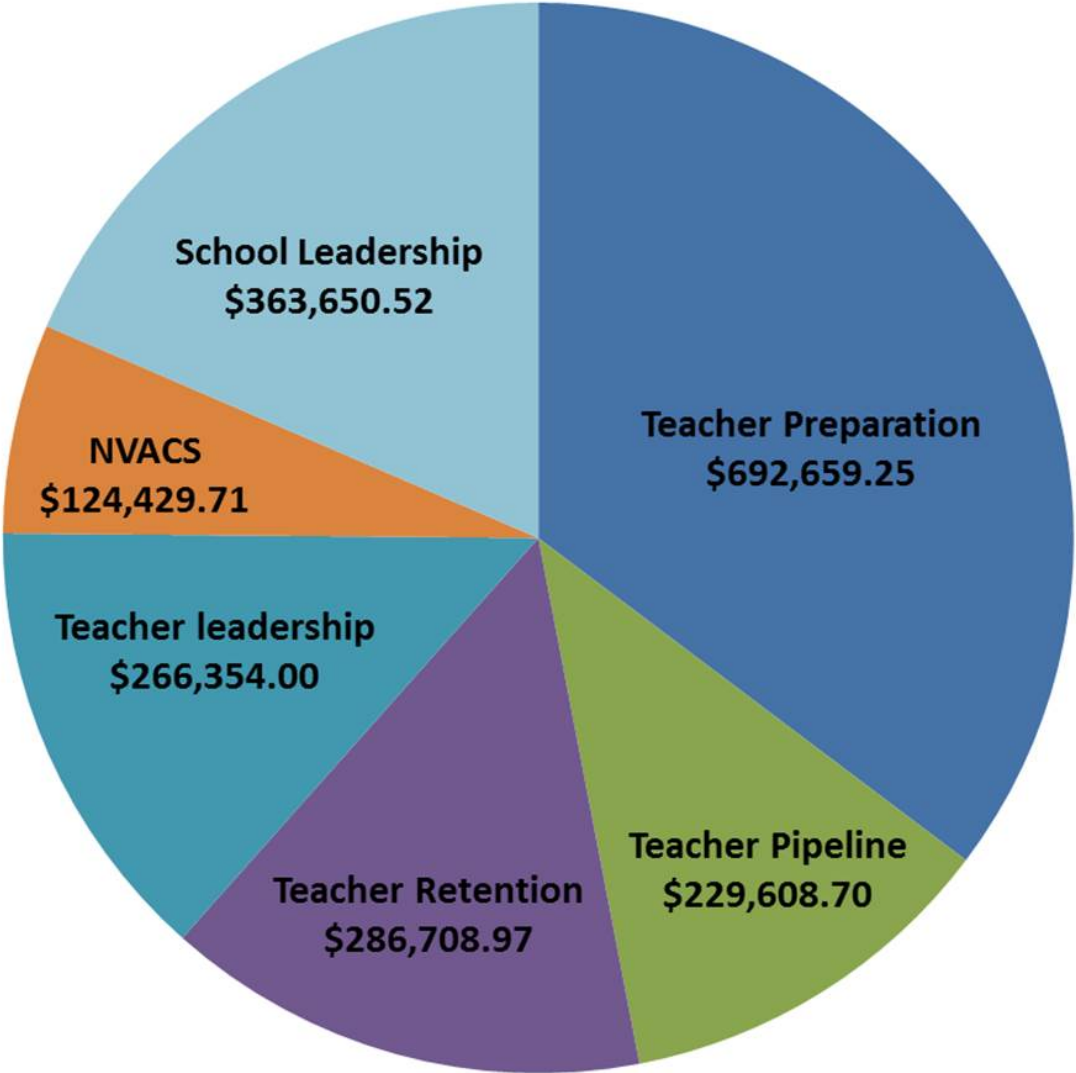

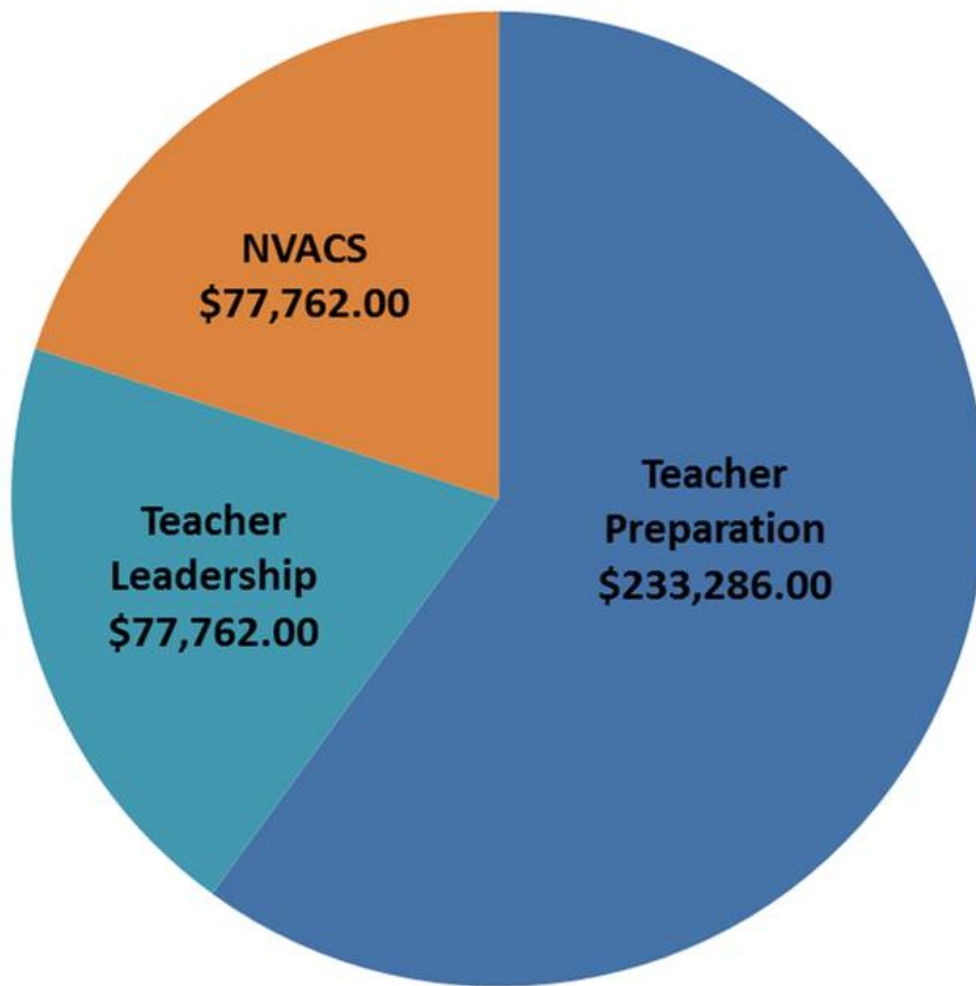
