



School Reopening

Instructional Delivery Model



- 1) Green / Gold Days (1/2 students every other day)
- 2) 'Schools PLP' (Online curriculum)
- 3) Performance-based learning
- 4) Zoom & Google Meets for online collaboration

Connectivity



- Beginning last June used federal and local dollars to purchase 460 Chromebooks
- 2) Paying \$40/month for over 40 'MiFi' units. Families eligible for free-or-reduced-price lunch receive free access.

Social-emotional support



- 1) Counselor or social worker in every school
- 2) Collaboration with community services
- 3) Food availability to ALL students

Assembly Bill 3



- Vent cleaning in elementary school, junior high, and high schol
- 2) Schools PLP licensing (Cost went from \$20K to \$120K)

Reopening Challenges



- 1) Staffing
 - Spring recruiting was halted
 - Some have had to leave the profession for the sake of safety
 - Difficult to recruit to rural / remote town
- 2) Funding

- 1) Staff and students have been resilient
- 2) Board and community have been supportive!
