The Need for Mentoring

Young Adults with a Mentor Are:

- 55 percent less than their peers to skip a day of school.
- 46 percent less likely than their peers to start using drugs.
- 81 percent more likely to report regularly in sports extracurricular activities.

Highlights of Duties Defined under NRS 385

- Award grants to mentorship programs
- Enter into public-private partnership with business
- Establish model guidelines for mentor programs
- Develop capacity building grants for mentoring programs
