

Special - Grades K-12 Navajo Language and Government of the Navajo Nation NAC 391.231

- 1. Hold a high school diploma or its equivalent; and
- 2. Completed six (6) semester credits of coursework to include the following:
 - A. Professional education and teaching methodology; or
 - B. The study of the Navajo language and government of the Navajo Nation; and
- 3. Be certified as a fluent speaker of the Navajo language by:
 - A. A chapter of the Navajo Nation
 - B. The Tribal Council of the Colorado River Indian Tribes; or
 - C. A qualified official of a university or college

An applicant for a Navajo language and government of the Navajo Nation endorsement is not required to meet the requirements of the Praxis series tests.
