## Nevada English Learner Program Participation and Reclassification Protocol for English Learners with Disability (ELWD) WIDA Alternate ACCESS for ELLs Grades 1-12

**Purpose:** This English Learners with Disability (ELWD) Participation and Reclassification Protocol for WIDA Alternate ACCESS for ELLs is intended for English learners with the **most significant cognitive disabilities and who have an Individualized Education Program (IEP)** and who, based on the severity of cognitive disabilities, are precluded from equitably taking the WIDA ACCESS assessment with accommodations.

The **English learner (EL) Designee** (ELAD/TESL endorsed or expertise in second language acquisition and knowledge of the particular student's language proficiency level needs who is authorized by the district/SPCSA to make EL assessment decisions), in consultation with the special education case manager, parent/guardian, and site administrator will decide whether a student's language ability in conjunction with the student's disability should be assessed using an Alternate Language Proficiency Assessment.

## **Pre-Assessment Determination:**

**Step I:** The EL Designee, in consultation with the special education case manager, parent/guardian, and site administrator, discusses the **Alternate ACCESS for ELLs** participation and EL reclassification process. This decision must occur prior to the annual ACCESS administration. While not required, this decision could occur during an annual IEP meeting.

**Step II**: For English learners with the most significant cognitive disabilities, the EL Designee, in consultation with the special education case manager, the parent/guardian, and site administrator decides whether the most appropriate way to assess English language proficiency is with the WIDA Alternate ACCESS for ELLs. Use the **Alternate ACCESS for ELLs Participation Decision Tree** in the current, WIDA Accessibility-Accommodations Manual to help inform your decision.

**Note:** Students, grades 1 and 2 who meet this determination may participate in the Alternate ACCESS assessment. Students who are taking the Alternate ACCESS in grades 3 and above, must also meet <u>Nevada Alternative Assessment (NAA) decision criteria</u> and take the NAA for ELA and Math. If students, grades 3 and above are taking the SBAC assessments, they cannot take the Alternate ACCESS for English language proficiency.

#### ★ Complete Protocol Part 1: Student Information Form

**Step III:** The English learner with disability is administered the WIDA Alternate ACCESS during the annual ELPA testing window.

#### **Post-Assessment Determination:**

**Step IV:** After the school receives the WIDA assessment results, and the **composite overall proficiency level is P2,** the EL Designee, in consultation with the special education case manager, parent/guardian, and site administrator will decide whether the student should be reclassified from EL services.

★ Complete Protocol Part 2: EL Reclassification Determination

**Step V:** If the student is reclassified from the EL program, the LEA EL Data Designee will update the student's EL status to Exited-ALT in the student information system prior to October 1. (Exited EL students must not be designated as a current EL on October 1 enrollment count).
