Nevada English Learner Program Alternate Reclassification Protocol: 4.0-4.4

Purpose: The **Reclassification Protocol 4.0-4.4** is intended for a student who met content proficiency on the State Summative ELA and Math assessments. The WIDA ACCESS For ELLs English Language Proficiency Overall Composite score must at least be a 4.0. Students in Grades 3-12 are the only EL students eligible for the Alternate English Proficiency pathway.

Description: Apply protocol to an English learner's WIDA ACCESS **results** to determine if the individual student meets the alternate reclassification criteria.

Step I: School designated staff member verifies the reclassification criteria. Evidence of:

- WIDA ACCESS Overall Composite score of 4.0-4.4
- ELA and Math results on SBAC (grades 3-8) or ACT (grade 11)
