## 2021-22 Private School Enrollment Report Overview

Per NAC 394, on or before October 15, private schools are required to submit two data points to the Nevada Department of Education to be posted publicly on the Department's website.

The first data collected are total student enrollment by gender and grade level. In the current 2021-2022 school year, total enrollment in private schools is 20,893 , which represents a 7.55 percent increase over school year 2020-2021.

The second data are the qualifications of each teacher employed by the school. Per NAC 394.050, each teacher employed by a private school must have one of three qualifications:
(a) Hold a teacher's license issued by the Department or by another state or territory of the United States that is appropriate for the instructor's assignment;
(b) Hold a bachelor's degree from an institution accredited by a regional accrediting association that is approved by the United States Department of Education and have 3 years of verified full-time or supervised experience in teaching the appropriate grade level; or
(c) Hold a master's degree in an area that is appropriate for the instructor's assignment from an institution accredited by a regional accrediting association that is approved by the United States Department of Education and have 1 year of verified full-time or supervised experience in teaching the appropriate grade level.

The total number of teachers employed by private schools by county and the qualification of those teachers are included in this report.
