







# Seals of Completion

State Seals of Biliteracy, Civics, Financial Literacy, STEM, and STEAM require demonstrations of proficiency by GPA and/or assessment.



# Seal of Biliteracy



- **GPA:** 2.00 (4.0 scale)
- **Demonstrate Proficiency - Meet one of the following**
  - A score of **Intermediate Mid** on the OPI
  - A score of **3 or higher** on the Advanced Placement (AP) World Language and Culture exam
  - A score of **Level i3** in all modes of the ACTFL- AAPPL
  - A score of **Intermediate Mid** on the STAMP assessment in both Writing/Speaking and Reading/Listening levels
  - An International Baccalaureate score of **4 or higher**
  - A Score of **3.0 or higher** on the ASLPI or **Intermediate Plus** on the SLPI in American Sign Language
- **Course Requirements:**
  - English Language Arts – 4 credits
  - Students must demonstrate proficiency in English by meeting State high school graduation requirements in English

# Seal of Civics – Beginning 2022-2023

- **GPA:** 3.25 (4.0 scale) or 3.85 weighted
- **Demonstrate Proficiency:**
  - Earn a score of 90% on Civics Exam
  - Satisfactory score in citizenship
- **Application:**
  - Complete a service-learning project
- **Course Requirements:**
  - Social Studies – 3 Credits
    - Including (not limited to) civics, criminal justice, contemporary problems, economics, financial literacy, macroeconomics, microeconomics, US Government, US History, World History

# Seal of Financial Literacy



- **GPA:** 3.25 (4.0 scale) or 3.85 weighted
- **Demonstrate Proficiency - Meet one of the following**
  - Earn a score of 85% on a Financial Literacy Assessment provided by the Nevada Department of Education
  - A grade of B or higher in a college level course in financial literacy
  - A score of gold or higher on the ACT National Career Readiness Certificate
- **Course Requirements:**
  - Social Studies – 3 Credits
    - Including algebra with personal finance, economics, financial literacy, life skills with financial literacy, macroeconomics, microeconomics, US Government, US History, World History

# Seal of STEM



- ▶ GPA: 3.25 (4.0 scale) or 3.85 weighted
- ▶ Course Requirements:
  - ▶ Science – 3 credits
  - ▶ Mathematics – 4 credits
  - ▶ 1 credit – Computer Science, Engineering, Manufacturing, Electronics, or CTE program of study in information & media technologies or skilled & technical sciences
- ▶ Meet any ONE of the following:
  - ▶ Score 3 or higher on AP Exam in Science OR math
  - ▶ Score 4 or higher on IB Exam in Science OR math
  - ▶ SAT Score: 650 or higher in Science OR 530 or higher in math
  - ▶ ACT Score: 23 or higher in Science OR 22 or higher in math
  - ▶ Grade of B or higher in college-level science OR mathematics course (dual enrollment)
  - ▶ Gold or higher on ACT National Career Readiness Certificate

# Seal of STEAM



- ▶ GPA: 3.25 (4.0 scale) or 3.85 weighted
- ▶ Course Requirements:
  - ▶ Science – 3 credits
  - ▶ Mathematics – 4 credits
  - ▶ Fine Arts – 1 credit
  - ▶ 1 credit – Computer Science, Engineering, Manufacturing, Electronics, or CTE program of study in information & media technologies or skilled & technical sciences
- ▶ Meet any ONE of the following:
  - ▶ Score 3 or higher on AP Exam in Science OR math
  - ▶ Score 4 or higher on IB Exam in Science OR math
  - ▶ SAT Score: 650 or higher in Science OR 530 or higher in math
  - ▶ ACT Score: 23 or higher in Science OR 22 or higher in math
  - ▶ Grade of B or higher in college-level science OR mathematics course (dual enrollment)
  - ▶ Gold or higher on ACT National Career Readiness Certificate




