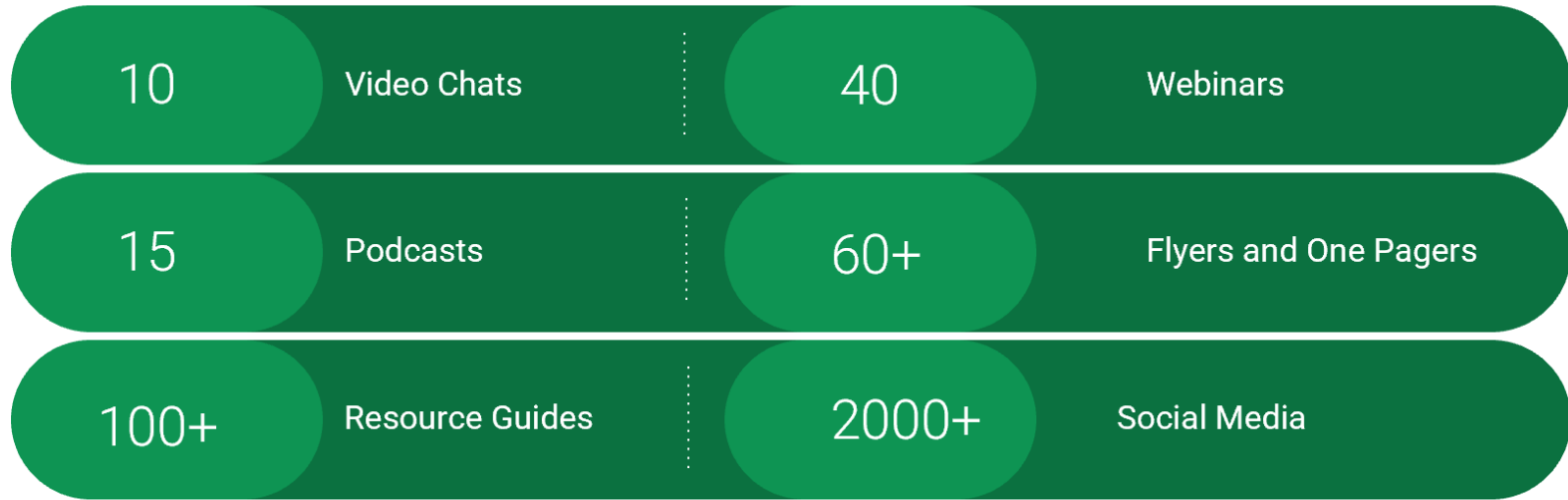

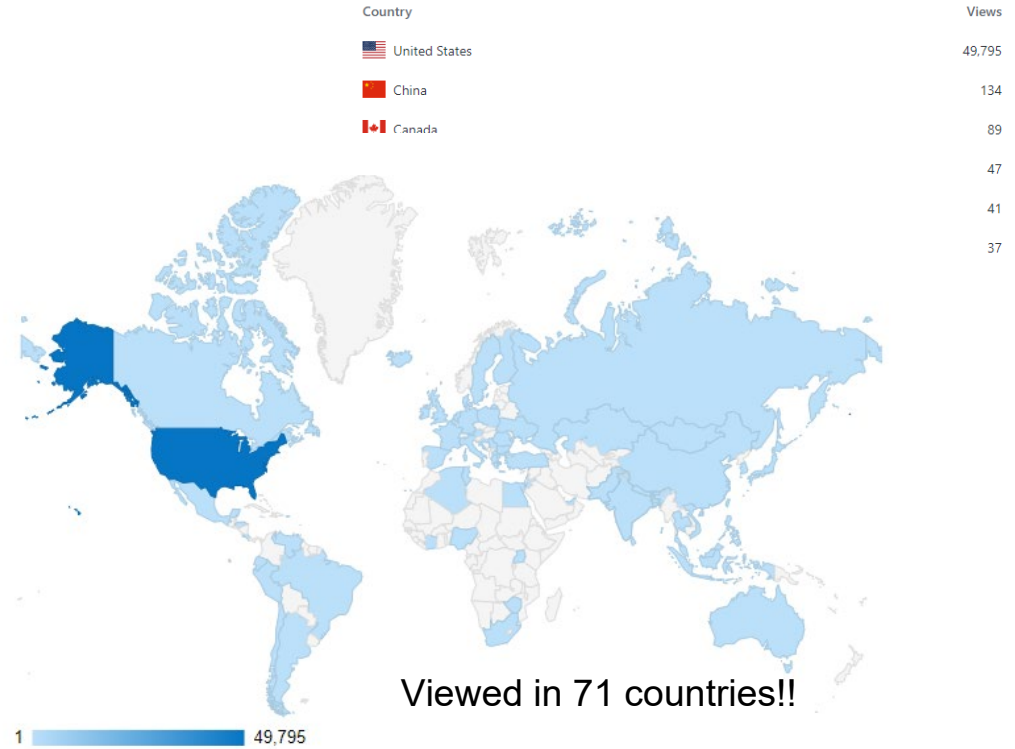

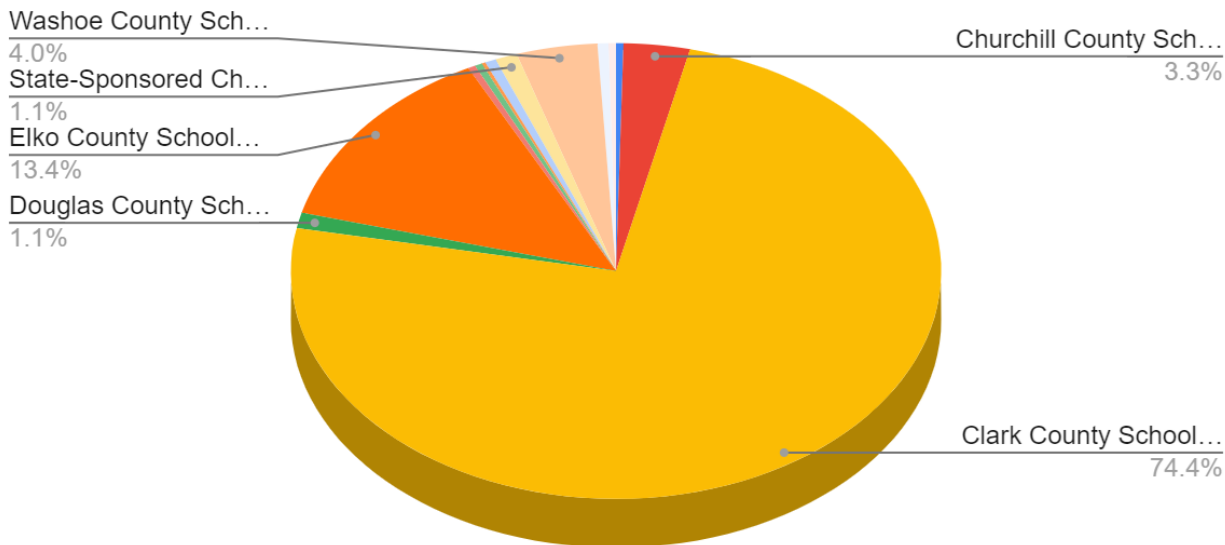

Student Survey Feedback

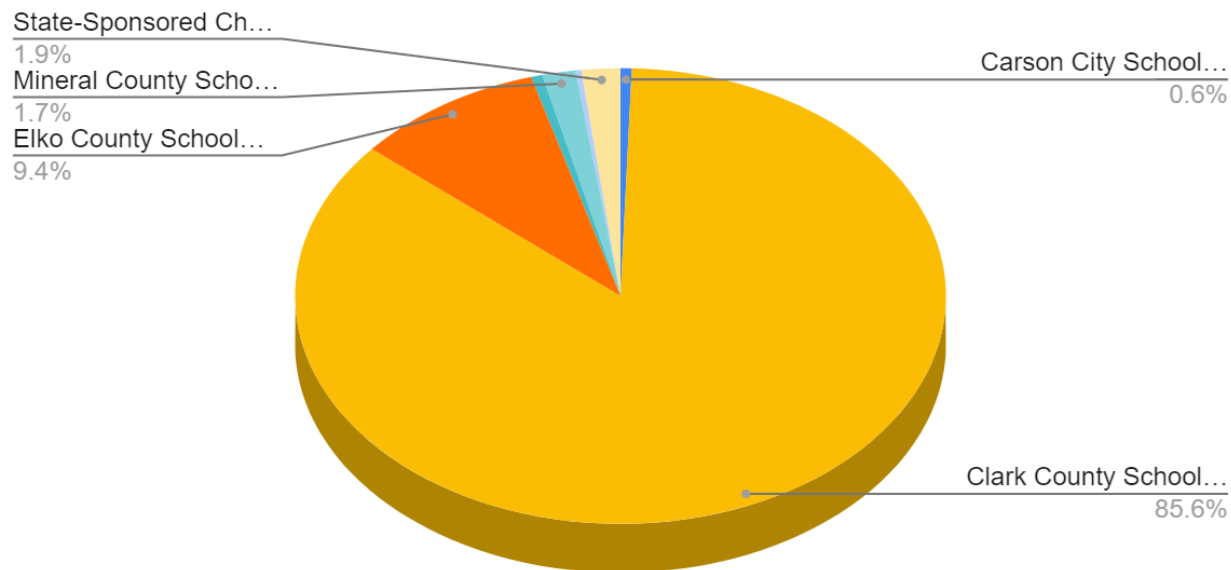
Challenges:

Family Survey Feedback

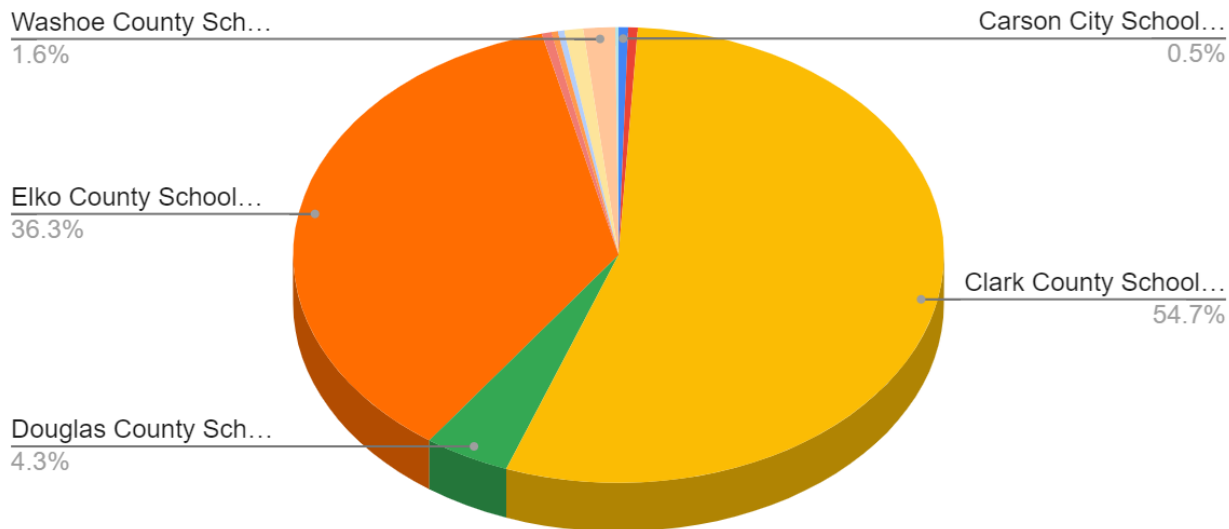
Challenges:

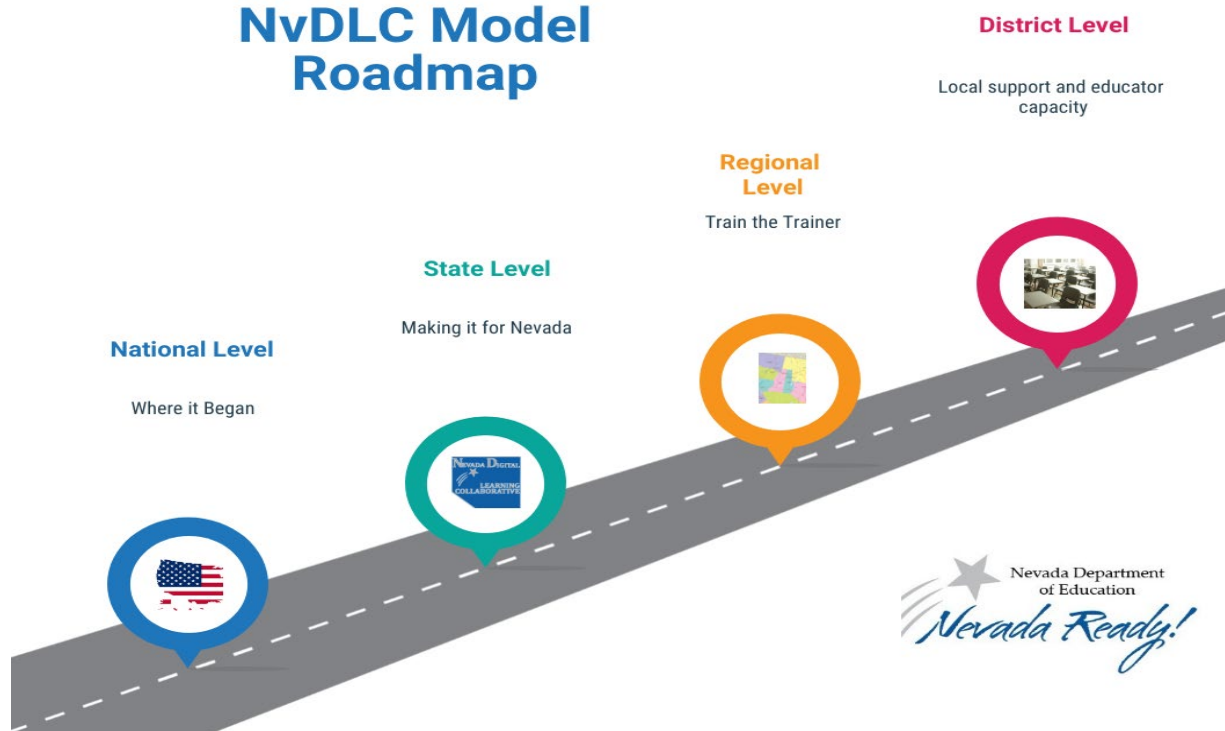
