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RECAP

- July 31, 2018 Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V)
- May 2, 2019 presented to the Nevada State Board of Education
- July 1, 2019 full implementation
- Keeps Perkins IV largely intact w/increased emphases:
 - ✓ access for ALL students to high-quality CTE programs
 - √ employer engagement
 - √ high-skill, high-wage, or in-demand occupations and industries
 - ✓ state and local flexibilities



PERKINS V: STATE PLANS

Year 1 (July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019)

State Board Approved "one-year transition" plan submitted to USDOE April 30, 2019

Years 2-4 (July 1, 2020-June 30, 2023)

"full, consolidated four-year" state plan due to USDOE April 30, 2020

TIMELINE

October 1-December 1, 2019: Perkins V State Plan draft published for required 30- and 60-day public comment period

November 14, 2019: Perkins V State Plan presented to Nevada State Board of Education as *informational item*

December 1-December 31, 2019: Perkins V State Plan submitted to Governor for a 30-day required review period. (*The Governor*

had the option to sign the plan or decline to sign the plan.)

December 12, 2019: Perkins V State Plan presented to Nevada State Board of Education as *informational and*

possible action item (with public comments incorporated, Exhibit A)

January 2020 (tbd): Perkins V State Plan presented to Governor's Workforce Development Board as informational

item

April 2020 (tbd): Perkins V State Plan submitted to USDOE (120 days to review/respond)
