Background: Ateres Bnos Ita is committed to providing an excellent education in an environment of warmth, love, and growth to the high school girls in the community by teaching both Judaic and secular preparatory classes that inspire students to pursue personal growth, higher education, and to be leaders in their communities. Students also commit to a life built on values of the Torah. There are mandates of community services hours as part of the graduation requirements.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve The King's Academy for a license for two years from October 31, 2022, through October 31, 2024. The King's Academy has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements

The school is starting out with eight students this year and one teacher but has the capacity for up to 16 students and another teacher.

The school teaches to mastery using the Accelerated Christian Education curriculum. Learning is individualized so students can work at their own pace. Students take diagnostic assessments for placement; those who excel in their work may advance at a faster pace. Learners who need to take more time move forward at a pace that allows them to absorb the material. The school uses the Stanford 10 Achievement Test to assure students are making sufficient progress.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve The Church at Reno Christian Academy for a license for two years from October 31, 2022, through October 31, 2024. The Church at Reno Christian Academy has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements

The school uses the Common Core State Standards and Nevada Content Standards as the basis of its curriculum. Students in grades K-12 study all required subjects as well as Spanish, Communications, Foundations of Life, and the Bible.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve University Baptist Academy for a license for two years from October 31, 2022, through October 31, 2024. University Baptist Academy has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements

Background: Faith Lutheran Middle School and High School is the largest non-public school in Nevada. The school was founded in 1979 and is affiliated with Lutheran Church, Missouri Synod. Faith Lutheran is accredited by Cognia, formerly AdvancEd and through National Lutheran Schools Accreditation, which awarded the school with "Exemplary School Status." The school is college prep and offers students the opportunity to earn college credit or have introductory courses waved through Advanced Placement courses. Faith Lutheran offers honors level courses as well. In recent years, 98 percent of the school's graduates enrolled in colleges or universities.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Faith Lutheran Middle School and High School for a license of four years from October 31, 2022, through October 31, 2026. Faith Lutheran Middle School and High School has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.

Elementary and middle school students learn through a rigorous, standards-based curriculum with experiences that develop 21st century skills such as creativity, collaboration and communication. The school features Giving Without Walls service projects in which students can apply what they've learned to community projects that benefit those in need.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Southern Highlands Preparatory Academy for a license for two years from October 31, 2022, through October 31, 2026. Southern Highlands Preparatory Academy has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements

School Name: The Meadows School, Clark County

Background: The Meadows School was founded in 1984 by Board President Carolyn Goodman and Dr. LeOre Cobbley and a group of parents. The school is reported to be the first non-sectarian K-12 college preparatory schools in Nevada. The Meadows School campus houses over 240,000 square feet of state-of-the-art facilities. The school places high value on academic rigor; teachers inspirate students by promoting independent thinking, problem-solving and continual growth. Since the first graduating class in 1991, 100 percent of Meadows graduates have been accepted to four-year colleges and universities. The Meadows School is accredited by Cognia.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Faith Lutheran Middle School and High School for a license of four years from September 30, 2022, through September 30, 2026. Faith Lutheran Middle School and High School has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.

Background: Trinity International School was founded in 1978 as Trinity Christian School by Trinity Temple. Today, it is an independent, nonprofit educational school delivering "excellent education coupled with virtues." The middle school focuses on teaching students to become "self-directed learners who make meaningful and deliberate choices on how to profit from their educational opportunities." The teachers work to stimulate inquiry and acquisition of knowledge. The high school prepares students for leadership by building intellectual competence and social emotional intelligence that fosters personal growth and ultimately motivates students to serve the needs of others. Students are involved in a variety of classroom activities and challenges as well as group projects associated with community service.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Trinity International School for a license for two years from October 1, 2022, through October 1, 2026. Trinity International School has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve four-year licenses for the following schools.

BACKGROUND:

Private education institutions are covered by Chapter 394 in both the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Nevada Administrative Code. The Private Schools Education Program Professional verifies that the statutory and regulatory requirements are met. The Nevada State Board of Education approves the issuing of a private school license. Most private schools are approved for a license for two years; however, NRS 394.251 allows a school to be licensed for four years after it has been in operation for four years. Both Bethlehem Lutheran School and Faith Christian Academy meet that requirement. These licenses were previously approved by the State Board of Education at the July 7, 2022 meeting for two years.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Bethlehem Lutheran School for a license for four years from July 31, 2022, through July 31, 2026. Bethlehem Lutheran School has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements and has no verified complaints against it. Bethlehem Lutheran School was approved for a two-year license by the State Board of Education at its meeting on July 7, 2022. The request for the two-year license was submitted in error. It was approved in the previous cycle for a four-year license, which was effective July 16, 2018, through July 31, 2022. Bethlehem Lutheran School is located at 1837 Mountain Street in Carson City, Nevada.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Faith Christian Academy for a license for four years from July 31, 2022, through July 31, 2026. Faith Christian Academy has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements and has no verified complaints against it. Faith Christian Academy was approved for a two-year license at the board's meeting on June 2, 2022. The request for the two-year license was submitted in error. The school had been approved for four-year licenses in the past. Its last license was in effect from July 25, 2018, through July 31, 2022. Faith Christian Academy is located at 1004 Dresslerville in Gardnerville, Nevada.
