Sustainability Grant \$3,000 - \$5,000	<p>Sustainability Phase: This phase is for organizations that have established a running record of statistically significant data for addressing the NCOM areas of focus (Family Health and Wellness, Criminal Justice, and Academic Capacity Building). The Organization must continuously meet the conditions set regarding the Sustainability Phase to receive reimbursements.</p>
Implementation Grant \$2,000 - \$3,000	<p>Implementation Phase: This phase is considered official implementation with established standards for completing the work effectively, and clearly established contingencies for NCOM monitoring. Demonstration of the Implementation Phase contingencies is a prerequisite for receiving a NCOM Sustainability Grant. The Organization must continuously m</p>
Startup Grant \$1,000 - \$2,000	<p>Startup Phase: This phase begins the work of engaging with mentees, collecting data, and determining the effectiveness of mentor organization infrastructure for effective implementation. Demonstration of the Startup Phase contingencies is a prerequisite for receiving a NCOM Implementation Grant.</p>
Planning Grant \$1,000	<p>Planning Phase: This phase ensures the teams are in good standing as an official business registered with the State, the project is strategically thought out with SMART Goals and a methodology for monitoring effectiveness, and team capacity for service delivery of the mentoring model. Development of a "Capacity Budget": LLC - \$450.00 Non-profit - \$ Marketing - \$ Project Investment materials - \$ Demonstration of the Planning Phase contingencies is a prerequisite for receiving a NCOM Startup Grant.</p>
