Senate Bill 108 Overview

> Senate Bill (SB) 108 (2017)

"The State Board of Education shall create a subcommittee to study the manner in which to include, in one of the three units of credit in **social studies** required pursuant to NRS 389.018 instruction concerning crimes that frequently involve persons under the age of 18 years."



SB 108 Subcommittee Summary

- □ Last Meeting: April 1, 2018
 □ Subcommittee Members: Felicia Ortiz, Robert Blakely, Dawn Miller, Hunter Dross; Mary Holsclaw and Brett Barley
- **☐** Subcommittee Recommendations:
 - 1. Content should be addressed in an age-appropriate manner, starting in grade 3 (i.e. sexting and distributing of photos since some children are getting phones as young as 8)
 - 2. This content would ideally be delivered as part of an existing lesson
 - 3. Provide appropriate professional learning and support for teachers to learn this content. Consider offering a 9th grade class that covers this content as well as other content that students are asking for (e.g. sex education, life skills, financial literacy)
 - 4. Using existing resources, lessons should be differentiated starting in the primary grades
 - 5. School districts will work with external partners to accomplish the requirements of the bill

- ❖ Nevada Department of Education (NDE) will curate a list of highquality instructional materials for educators and provide crosswalks between relevant content areas
 - Aligns to Subcommittee Recommendations 1 and 2
 - *NDE* anticipates the release of this item by the summer of 2021
- ❖ NDE will provide professional development opportunities for educators to learn how to incorporate the high-quality instructional materials into the relevant content areas
 - Aligns to Subcommittee Recommendations 3 and 4
 - *NDE* anticipates the release of this item by the winter of 2021
- * Review current legislation to ensure appropriate placement within the academic content areas
