Revised Regulation R008-24 (09/16/2024)

1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: [General License Requirements](#)
2. Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university; and
3. Complete twenty-two (22) semester credits to include:
 - A. Eight (8) semester credits of supervised teaching; and
 - B. Completion of a course in the methods and materials of teaching a field of specialization (Example: methods of teaching secondary math); and
 - C. Three (3) semester credits in strategies for working with students with disabilities, including curricular adaptation; and
 - D. Any other courses in secondary education
4. In addition to the secondary education requirements, the applicant must submit evidence of a major in one of the secondary content areas listed in [NAC 391.1301](#) (section 1) or [NAC 391.131](#)
