

Secondary Career and Technical Education Grades 7-12 <u>NAC 391.120</u>

- 1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: <u>General License Requirements</u>
- 2. Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university with the major or minor in career and technical education <u>or</u> in the requested endorsement area; <u>and</u>
 - A) Twenty-three (23) semester credits in secondary education as follows:
 - 1. Eight (8) semester credits of student teaching
 - 2. Three (3) semester credits in the methods of teaching career and technical education
 - 3. Three (3) semester credits in secondary curriculum and instruction
 - 4. Three (3) semester credits in career development and work-based learning
 - 5. Three (3) semester credits in management of pupil organization in career and technical education
 - 6. Any other courses in secondary education
- 3. One (1) year of verifiable work experience (paid or unpaid) in a business, industry, or agency that is in the requested endorsement area; <u>and</u>
- 4. Valid license issued by a licensing authority of the State of Nevada in the requested endorsement area if one is required for employment in the State of Nevada

Exemptions:

If you hold a valid secondary license, you are not required to complete the following: Three (3) semester credits in the methods of teaching career and technical education; <u>and</u> Three (3) semester credits in secondary curriculum and instruction
