



Secondary Education Instrumental Music

1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: [General License Requirements](#)
2. Meet the [secondary education requirements](#); and
3. **For the comprehensive major:**
Thirty-six (36) semester credits required for a major in instrumental music must include:
 - A. Twenty-four (24) semester credits to include at least three (3) semester credits in each of the following areas:
 1. Music theory
 2. History or literature of music
 3. Applied music in instrumental music which must be in an area of specialization; and
 4. Piano
 - B. Twelve (12) semester credits to include at least three (3) semester credits in each of the following areas:
 1. Conducting
 2. Music ensemble; and
 3. Techniques and pedagogy for brass, woodwind, string and percussion instruments
4. **For the comprehensive minor:**
Twenty-four (24) semester credits required for a minor in instrumental music must include:
 - A. Fifteen (15) semester credits to include at least three (3) semester credits in each of the following areas:
 1. Music theory
 2. History or literature of music
 3. Applied music in instrumental music which must be in an area of specialization; and
 4. Piano
 - B. Nine (9) semester credits in the following:
 1. Conducting
 2. Music ensemble; and
 3. Techniques and pedagogy for brass, woodwind, string and percussion instruments

Note: A secondary minor endorsement may only be issued if the licensee already holds a secondary major endorsement.
