

## Secondary Academic 7-12 Endorsement in Instrumental and Vocal Music

## NAC 391.13046

- 1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: General License Requirements
- 2. Meet the secondary academic requirements; and

## 3. For the comprehensive major:

Thirty-six (36) semester credits required for a major in instrumental and vocal music must include:

- A. Twenty-four (24) semester credits to include at least three (3) semester credits in each of the following areas:
  - 1. Music theory
  - 2. History or literature of music
  - 3. Applied music, including training in vocal and instrumental music
  - 4. Piano; and
  - 5. Techniques and pedagogy for brass, woodwind, string and percussion instruments
- B. Twelve (12) semester credits to include at least three (3) semester credits in each of the following areas:
  - 1. Conducting
  - 2. Music ensemble; and
  - 3. Choral literature, diction or vocal techniques and pedagogy

## 4. For the comprehensive minor:

Twenty-four (24) semester credits required for a minor in instrumental and vocal music must include:

- A. Fifteen (15) semester credits to include at least three (3) semester credits in each of the following areas:
  - 1. Music theory
  - 2. History and literature of music
  - 3. Applied music in vocal and instrumental music; and
  - 4. Piano
- B. Nine (9) semester credits in the following:
  - 1. Conducting
  - 2. Music ensemble
  - 3. Techniques and pedagogy for brass, woodwind, string and percussion Instruments; and
  - 4. Choral literature, diction or vocal techniques and pedagogy
